'EMBRACE NEW TECHNOLOGY'

Change mindset to escape poverty, PM tells farmers, fishermen

MARANG: Farmers and fishermen have been urged to change the old mindset of depending on government handouts and instead, embrace new technology to escape poverty.

Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said fishermen should strive to become more innovative to improve their standing

ing.

"Shed outdated ways. Cultivate new methods and diversify to increase productivity and improve your earnings. Do not just depend on government incentives, subsidies and handouts, for you will remain poor forever.

"You should instead strive to find ways to enrich yourselves so that you can be proud of your own initiatives and efforts," he told farmers and fishermen at the Marang district town hall yesterday.

Dr Mahathir called on farmers and fishermen to do away with traditional ways and become more innovative and versatile.

"For instance, make use of modern machinery and technology to increase productivity.

"Padi farmers should not restrict themselves to just planting, but diversify into processing their harvests to earn extra income. Likewise, fishermen should not stick with their traditional boats but look at operating deepsea fishing vessels that have cold

storage facilities," he said.

Present were Terengganu Menteri Besar Dr Ahmad Samsuri Mokhtar, Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Minister Datuk Salahuddin Ayub and Housing and Local Government Deputy Minister Senator Raja Datuk Kamarul Bahrin Shah Raja Ahmad.

Dr Mahathir said the federal government would do everything possible to lift the socio-economy of farmers and fishermen.

"If possible, small farmers with a few hectares of land should consolidate with others to form larger entities.

"This way, you can share your resources, minimise overhead, become more efficient and enjoy greater revenue."

He urged farmers not to be too dependent on commodities like rubber and palm oil given their fluctuating prices.

"Supplement your income by venturing into other crops, like vegetables and fruits, so that when the prices of rubber and palm oil drop, you can fall back on the other produce.

"Use the spare time for other income-generating activities like cottage industries to manufacture *keropok*, handicraft products from rattan and bamboo, and basket weaving," he said, adding that such activities only needed small capital.

Fish prices up due to bad weather and CNY

PETALING JAYA: Fish prices are likely to increase due to supply shortage as the uncertain weather conditions continue, say traders and fishermen.

Sungai Besar Haisan Fishermen Association chairman Sia Chock Sung said the rainy season in December and January usually drives up prices by between 10% and 20%. "During these months, fishermen catch less

"During these months, fishermen catch less fish as compared to May to June when the weather is hotter.

"The temperature of the sea water has an impact on fishes too," he said.

As Chinese New Year approaches, he said, the demand for prawns, threadfin and pomfret will be higher boosting prices further

fret will be higher, boosting prices further.
"The prices could be up 25% to 30%. Usually
the prices go upwards a month before the
Chinese New Year," Sia said.

He said bad weather on Jan 4 and Jan 5 prevented fishermen from going out to sea.

"But the fish boats went out to sea on Sunday, so supply should be normal again," he said.

Another fish trader, who declined to be identified, said fish supply was impacted by prolonged bad weather last year.

"It all depends on the weather. Last year, the rainy season stretched until March. But usually the price hike is only temporary," he said

He said the wholesale price of mackerel (ikan kembung) reached RM16 to RM18 per kg recently, compared to the usual RM12 to RM14.

He said the Fisheries Development Authority of Malaysia (LKIM) can also take steps to restrict exports if the price hike is tremendous.

It was reported that the LKIM has assured that prices of marine products, especially fish, will not increase despite the current uncertain weather conditions.

Its chairman Muhammad Faiz Fadzil said the LKIM had made early preparation to ensure sufficient supply of fish stocks.

He said the government had also taken steps to restrict exports of fish abroad to ensure adequate supply for the local market.

SPCA shocked over abuse and killing of stray dogs

PETALING JAYA: The Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) Selangor is shocked over the abuse and killing of stray dogs in Selayang, said its patron Tan Sri Lee Lam Thye.

Lee said he could not imagine how anyone could be so inhumane.

Cruelty to animals comes in different forms and the latest incident is an example of this, he said.

"Animals are beaten by humans because of their emotions like anger, dissatisfaction or stress, while some sadists may just do it for pleasure.

"I urge all parties to assist the police and Department of Veterinary Services (DVS) in their efforts to find the culprits," he said.

Lorry driver Amar Singh, 56, and his wife Daljit Kaur, 52, found five puppies and their mother poisoned while three others had their legs and body chopped off at the People's Housing Project Wahyu 2 in Selayang.

The couple stumbled upon the carcasses on Sunday and buried them.

Lee said the authorities should leave no stone unturned and the harshest punishment should be imposed on those responsible.

"Those found guilty of abusing the animals can be fined between RM20,000 and RM100,000 or jailed up to three years or both.

"The public must continue to act as the eyes and ears of the authorities and share information with them," he said, adding that they should also take videos of culprits abusing animals, when possible, and post them online to shame hese abusers.


