## Climate change threatens our food security

As a senior soil scientist working to help enhance rice production to sustain food security, I am worried about the situation. No matter what we do, if there is insufficient irrigation water, the agro-technologies we have developed are of little use, unless there is a rice variety available in the country that can withstand without much water during the vegetative stage. What has gone wrong with the climate in Peninsular Malaysia of late?

To put it in proper perspective, I made a visit to the area in mid-March. The visit was to start a research project with farmers in Pendang, Kedah, who wanted to participate in the project. Sad to say that water was lacking in some areas that rice plants in the fields were left unattended.

The rice plants turned brown due to insufficient water to support their growth. The plants could no longer grow or survive, let alone produce rice that the farmers were looking for. It was a sad end to farmers' dream of having a good harvest.

Based on the geological record,

Kedah-Perlis plains were once inundated by sea water when the

sea rose to its highest level some 4,300 years ago. During that period of the geological history, mineral pyrite ( $\text{FeS}_2$ ) was formed and remained in the sediments where the Mada area is.

That geological episode leaves a fingerprint that affects soil fertility. During dry spells, the water table level drops and exposes the pyrite, which is subsequently oxidised, releasing acidity and toxic iron. The phenomenon affects rice production negatively.

This seems to be the case in certain rice fields in Pendang that I visited. The problem of high acidity and iron toxicity has to be rectified via agronomic means. The objective of my visit to Mada areas was to look for the best ways to do it. Alas, the project was put on hold until the Covid-19 pandemic is done and over with.

The rice self-sufficiency level

(SSL) in Malaysia stands at 71 per cent. With the improved infrastructure put in place, the SSL is expected to be increased to 80 per cent by 2022. The drought situation in Mada areas right now is made worse by the Covid-19 pandemic.

With the problems facing the agriculture fraternity across the globe, PIC BY SHAHZIRAL MD NOOR

farmers, I hope Malaysia can still sustain the SSL at 71 per cent. The powers-that-be should have already started working to alleviate the problem facing the rice farmers.

Recently, the government invited researchers nationwide to submit research proposals for Trans-disciplinary Research Grant and Long-term Research Grant Schemes. Among the 14 areas of research offered for full funding is "Impacts of 1.5-2.0°C Global Warming on Malaysia". This shows how important is the impact of global warming on the economic well-being of Malaysians.

The phenomenon of water shortage for rice production is unprecedented in the history of

Malaysia. Water in dams at the

upper reaches of rivers is almost

dry due to the lack of rainfall. It

has much to do with the change in weather patterns, the so-called global warming.

Global warming is of great concern among those in the agriculture fraternity across the globe. It is accelerated by the increase of carbon dioxide ( $\text{CO}_2$ ) concentration in the atmosphere. We have more than 400 ppm of  $\text{CO}_2$  in the atmosphere, almost double in amount compared with that before the industrial revolution.

The worldwide increase in the Earth's surface temperature has already reached the alarming level of 1.5°C increase in the Earth's surface temperature to 2°C.

# 10pc growth in rice sales in Sabah, says Bernas

**KOTA KINABALU:** Padiberas Nasional Bhd (Bernas) said sales of rice in Sabah rose nearly 10 per cent in the first three months of the year compared with the same period last year.

In a statement yesterday, Bernas said sales jumped 40 per cent this month from the average for the state.

"There was a 27 per cent increase in the number of rice wholesalers with no record of making purchases from Bernas, while around 61 per cent of

wholesalers in Sabah had bought more than the normal amount of rice. Of this, 37 wholesalers increased their purchases by more than 100 per cent," it said.

Bernas was responding to the "Bernas Urged Not To Ration Rice Supply in Sabah" news report on Wednesday, in which Malaysian Youth Council vice-president Azuwan Marjan said he had been informed by wholesalers in the state that Bernas had started rationing its rice supply to the group since April 13.

Bernas said unusually high purchases had prompted it to take precautionary steps by restricting sales to certain wholesalers to prevent hoarding.

It was aimed at preventing the rice supplied to Sabah from being sold to other countries, in view of the rice price in Malaysia being the lowest in Southeast Asia.

Bernas said a joint effort with the Agriculture and Food Industries Ministry to ensure the rice supply was controlled, would continue. **Bernama**

Beliau berkata, 3,844 operasi sanitasi awam dilakukan di 78 zon termasuk 13 zon merah sejak 30 Mac lalu.


Katanya, kerajaan menjamin bekalan makanan dan juga keperluan harian mencukupi bagi me-

# New SOP for different zones to be discussed soon – Minister

**KUCHING:** The National Security Council (MKN) is in the midst of coming up with new standard operating procedures (SOP) for green, yellow and red zones, says Senior Minister (Security Cluster) Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob.

He said the government would closely monitor the movement within the country, apart from strengthening border control.

"We have directed MKN to discuss with the Ministry of Health (MoH) and PDRM (Royal Malaysia Police) to come up with special SOP about the three zones – namely green, yellow and red."

Ismail Sabri, who is Defence Minister, said Putrajaya was aware of certain individuals complaining via social media about discrimination in the distribution of food aid from the government.

He believed that those who complained on social media

were not those who received the government's food aid.

According to him, some non-governmental organisations (NGOs) had also chipped in to complement the government's efforts in providing aid to the people.

"Some NGOs also help, and we don't decide for NGOs how much they want to help."

"Sometimes, they give RM30, RM70, RM100 or even RM200, depending on the NGO."

"And that is not food aid from JKJW (Welfare Department) but from the NGOs," he clarified.

Reiterating that the food supply across the country was sufficient, Ismail Sabri advised Malaysians not to worry about this issue during the holy Ramadan month.

He said the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Industry had given its assurance that fresh produce like vegetables, meat, chicken and eggs were more than sufficient to meet the country's demand.

"So do not worry about food supply and daily needs during Ramadan because we can assure you all that it is sufficient to meet the continued demand," he added.
