Nelayan boleh carum Perkeso

TAIPING -Seramai 42,000 nelayan buat julung kalinya dibenarkan mencarum dalam skim Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (Perkeso) mengikut Akta Perkeso Keselamatan Sosial Pekerjaan Sendiri 2017 (Akta 789), kata Menteri Pertanian dan Industri Makanan Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee.



Beliau berkata caruman di bawah Skim Keselamatan Sosial Pekerjaan Sendiri (SK-SPS) itu bagi menggantikan caruman insurans nelayan kelompok Lembaga Kemajuan Ikan Malaysia (LKIM), yang akan dilaksanakan mulai Sabtu depan (15 Ogos).

"Hari ini merupakan hari yang bersejarah untuk pertama kalinya pekerja sendiri dalam sektor perikanan dibolehkan oleh Akta Perkeso untuk mencarum dalam Perkeso.

"Ini akan memberi perlindungan kepada para nelayan (dan keluarga) dengan caruman akan diambil (dibayar) daripada elaun sara hidup nelayan," katanya pada 9 Ogos.

Katanya, cadangan caruman adalah RM157.20 setahun bagi semua nelayan berdaftar dengan LKIM dan layak menerima Elaun Sara Hidup Nelayan. - BERNAMA

Che Abdullah: 36 initiatives to revitalise agro sector, food production

BINTULU: Thirty-six initiatives under the Economic Stimulus Package (ESP) are now being implemented to revitalise the agriculture sector and food production that are affected by Covid-19 pandemic, says Deputy Minister of Agriculture and Food Industry Datuk Che Abdullah Mat Nawi.

He said the ministry has also planned seven special programmes through the Prihatin Economic Stimulus Package to increase the income of farmers, breeders and fishermen.

The seven programmes are Jaminan Bekalan Makanan programme (RM42 million); Insentif Logistik dan Pemasaran Nanas (RM13 mil); Simpanan Bekalan Makanan (RM30 mil); Dana Khas Persatuan Nelayan Kawasan ((RM15 mil); Pembekalan Ikan Segar dan Ikan Beku (RM30 mil); Dana Khas Pertubuhan Peladang Kawasan (RM50 mil), and Peningkatan Mobilisasi dan Logistik Bahan Makanan (RM10 mil).

Under Penjana (Pelan Jana

Semula Ekonomi Negara). Che Abdullah said the ministry has been allocated RM400 million to implement three initiatives.

The first initiative is a micro credit financing scheme offering Islamic loans with interest of 3.5 per cent for five years.

The second initiative 'kebuniti' (community gardening in urban and rural areas) is assistance in the form RM500 for individuals and RM50,000 for the community totalling RM10 million.

The third initiative (Agrofood mobility workforce programme) provides retraining for those in the agro-food industry.

Batang Lupar MP Dato Sri Rohani Abdul Karim earlier asked the ministry during question time in parliament on the government's latest programmes to increase the income of farmers, breeders and fishermen post Covid-19.

Che Abdullah said all programmes and projects listed under the ESP packages including infrastructure projects costing RM50 million, Prihatin and Penjana worth RM640 million

are being implemented through various departments and agencies under the ministry.

"The ministry hopes these initiatives, including programmes and projects as well as special assistance, can help ease the burden of the target groups affected by Covid-19. It also helps the whole economic sector to recover and continue their respective businesses and to revitalise the agriculture sector," he said.

On Rohani's supplementary question: how the ministry would ensure that basic food supply is sufficient without relying on imports.

Che Abdullah assured her that the supply of essential foods is sufficient for all.

He said among initiatives taken by the ministry to increase the income of farmers, breeders and fishermen are by giving various incentives like seeds, fertilisers, pesticides, and technical advice, including the provision of better road connectivity and other facilities.

LKIM complex in Tg Manis among projects to undergo feasibility review by ministry

BINTULU: The Malaysian Fisheries Development Authority (LKIM) Complex in Tanjong Manis would be among the completed projects to be studied by the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Industry to ensure optimal operations, says its deputy minister Datuk Che Abdullah Mat Nawi.

In this regard, he reiterated the minister Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee's assurance of prioritising the abandoned projects, which could not be utilised despite the government having spent so much on developing them.

"So (the LKIM Complex in) Tanjong Manis is on the list for us to study so that it can

be fully operational.

"The focus by the ministry today is the priority on the abandoned projects, instead of implementing new ones," he said in the Dewan Rakyat yesterday, adding that the emphasis would apply to any abandoned projects under his ministry.

Che Abdullah was responding to Tanjong Manis MP Yusuf Abd Wahab, who had raised the issue about the under-utilisation of the RM350-million LKIM Tanjong Manis Complex.

According to Yusuf, the complex has been there for a long time, but it has yet to run on optimal capacity for unknown reasons.

Animal farm in Bukit Cherakah forest reserve demolished

AN ILLEGAL cow and goat farm operating in the Bukit Cherakah forest reserve in Shah Alam has been demolished by authorities after its owner failed to move out.

A hut and two sheds which were used to house the cows and goats were torn down while three people were arrested during the joint operation.

The enforcement exercise involved 200 officers from the Petaling District Land Office, police, Selangor Veterinary Services Department, Shah Alam City Council and Selangor Water

Management Authority.

"We had to take action and demolish the structures because the owner failed to move out despite notices being sent, with the last one issued in February this year," said state environment, green technology, science, technology and innovation and consumer affairs committee chairman Flee Loy Sian in a statement.

He added that the state government would not allow anyone to carry out illegal activities in forest reserves in Selangor.

Apart from cows and goats, the owner also reared chickens, ducks and geese at the premises.

During the operation, a total of

27 cows and 59 goats were seized and housed temporarily at Ladang HMA Kasturi Sdn Bhd in Batu Arang.

Five motorcycles, one lorry, two water pumps and one generator were also confiscated during the raid.

"This case is being investigated under the National Forestry Act (Adoption) Enactment 1985, Section 32 (1) which states that no one is allowed to occupy or carry out any form of activity in a forest reserve," said Hee.

The penalty for the offence is a fine of not more than RM100,000, jail time of between six months and 10 years, or both.

OKU dituduh dera anjing

SUNGAI PETANI - Seorang lelaki kurang upaya pendengaran didakwa di Mahkamah Sesyen Sungai Petani semalam kerana mendera seekor anjing November tahun lalu.

Ketika pendakwaan dibacakan, Hakim N Priscilla Hemamalini meminta jurubahasa menggunakan suara lebih kuat agar didengari Orang Kena Saman (OKS), K Krisnamurthy, 60, yang kemudiannya menganggu faham namun dia mengaku tidak bersalah.

Krisnamurthy yang juga pengawal keselamatan didakwa bertindak melakukan perbuatan tidak munasabah sehingga menyebabkan kesakitan terhadap anjing pada 10 November 2019 lebih kurang 11.05 malam di Jalan Berangan menghala ke Taman Sri Wang, Sungai Petani.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Pegawai Pendakwa Jabatan Perkhidmatan Veterinar Kedah, Azizi Ngah Ahmad manakala OKS diwakili peguam Datuk S Ganesan.

Lelaki OKU dituduh aniaya anjing

SUNGAI PETANI - Seorang pengawal keselamatan dihadapkan ke Mahkamah Sesyen di sini semalam atas pertuduhan menganiaya seekor anjing pada November tahun lalu.

K. Krisnamurthy, 60, yang merupakan orang kelainan upaya (OKU) pendengaran bagaimanapun mengaku tidak bersalah sebaik pertuduhan terhadapnya dibacakan di hadapan Hakim N. Priscilla Hema-malini.

Berdasarkan kertas pertuduhan, tertuduh didapati dengan kejam atau secara tidak munasabah menyebabkan kesakitan atau penderitaan ke atas seekor anjing di Jalan Berangan menghala Taman Sri Wang di sini kira-kira pukul

11.05 malam, 10 November tahun lalu.

Pendakwaan terhadapnya dilakukan mengikut Seksyen 29(1)(e) Akta Kebajikan Halwan 2015 (Akta 772).

Jika sabit kesalahan, tertuduh boleh dihukum di bawah Seksyen 29(1) akta sama yang memperuntukkan hukuman denda tidak kurang RM20,000 dan tidak melebihi RM100,000 atau penjara sehingga tiga tahun atau kedua-duanya sekali.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Pegawai Pendakwa Jabatan Perkhidmatan Veterinar Negeri Kedah, Azizi Ngah Ahmad, manakala Krisnamurthy diwakili peguam, Datuk S. Ganesan.

Mahkamah menetapkan 20 September ini untuk sebutan semula kes.

MB panggil anak syarikat kerajaan negeri

SHAH ALAM – Kerajaan negeri akan memanggil lembaga pengurusan anak syarikat kerajaan negeri dalam isu pengambilalihan tanah seluas 72.8 hektar Taman Pengeluaran Kekal Makanan di Bestari Jaya, Kuala Selangor di sini.

Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, ini berikutan tindakan dilakukan syarikat tersebut tidak melalui Perbadanan Menteri Besar Selangor (MBD) yang dipengerusikannya.

"Saya akan melihat perkara ini dengan teliti dan serius dari segi kesan dan implikasi terhadap petani di kawasan tersebut yang terkesan dengan tindakan berkenaan.

"Selain itu, saya juga telah mengarahkan laporan segera berikaitannya dan sudah pasti kerajaan negeri tidak mahu menghalang atau mengganggu program-program bekalan makanan yang merupakan satu ini-

siatif dalam membantu rakyat," katanya pada sidang akhbar di sini semalam.

Kosmo/ semalam melaporkan kira-kira 23 petani dan penterak di Taman Pengeluaran Kekal Makanan di Bestari Jaya, Kuala Selangor di sini buntu apabila diminta keluar dari lokasi yang diusahakan lebih 20 tahun.

Amirudin memberitahu, siasatan akan dilakukan bagi mengenalpasti sama ada projek itu melibatkan anak syarikat kerajaan negeri atau sebaliknya. "Saya sangat maklum dan hal ini menjadi perhatian (kerajaan

negeri) sebelum dibangkitkan isunya (di Kosmo)," ujarnya.

Amirudin berharap petani terlibat memberikannya masa bagi melihat keseluruhan dakwaan tersebut sebelum sebarang keputusan dibuat.

Sementara itu, seorang penernak, Mohd. Fadzil Ibrahim, 67, bersyukur kerana isu tersebut mendapat perhatian sewajarnya

daripada Amirudin dan berharap ada keputusan menaberangangkan memihak kepada mereka.

"Taman Pengeluaran Kekal Makanan ini boleh dinaik taraf menjadi industri agropelancongan susulan kerap mendapat lawatan daripada pihak luar yang mahu mempelajari teknik digunakan kami dalam pengeluaran hasil tani dan ternakan," katanya.

kat dalam sektor ini.

"Saya minta jabatan dan agensi kerajaan di Johor melihat bagaimana kita boleh melaksanakan kaedah pembangunan pertanian melalui teknologi.

"Ini kita akan gerakkan secepat mungkin," katanya ketika berucap pada majlis Padanan

Pemiagaan Antara Konsortium Penternak Ayam Muslim Sdn. Bhd. dan Suruhanjaya Koperasi Malaysia di sini semalam.

Dalam pada itu, Hasni menyeru orang ramai untuk melibatkan diri dalam sektor pertanian kerana ia merupakan satu sektor berpotensi luas.

Dalam pada itu katanya, kerajaan negeri juga telah memulakan usaha menjayakan program Jaminan Bekalan Makanan.

"Kita bukan sahaja mahu memastikan masyarakat khususnya rakyat Johor mempunyai bekalan makanan mencukupi tetapi juga yang berkualiti," katanya.
