Visit by federal minister signifies move to strengthen national agro-food sector

KUCHING: The recent three-day working visil to Sarawak by cay working vista to Sarawak by Agriculture and Food Industries Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee served as a platform for the federal and state governments, target groups as well as industry players to discuss approaches to further increase agricultural production and streoptible the production and strengthen the

country's food security.

The visit was regarded as very important for the national agro-food sector in line with the planning and direction of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Industries

Agriculture and Food Industries (Mafi) Ihrough the National Agro-Food Policy 2021-2030 (DAN 2.0). Ronald's inaugural visit to the state kicked off on Thursday with a courlesy call on the Premier of Sarawak Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Abang Johari Tun Openg at Wisma Bapa Malaysia here, where discussions touched on several issues, including food security and involvement of the private sector in helping the government develop the agro-food sector.

In a press conference on the same day, Ronald said his ministry had set an allocation of RM150 million to develop the agra-food sector in Sarawak

He added that the allocation ould be channelled to various departments and agencies relevant to the agro-food sector, set to benefit sub-sectors such as plantation and livestock breeding. One of the things that the

efficiently managed, and at the same time, for it to be using the talest technology towards reducing cost of operation and dependency on imported goods, as well as increasing productivity," said the federal minister.

Also on Thursday, Ronald attended the 'Mañ Luncheon Talk with inclustry Players' held at Dewan Majma' Tunku Abd Hairm Mu' adzam Shah here, where he had a dialogue with inclustry players in the agro-food action of the minister of the series of the series. sector covering fisheries, crops, livestock sub-sectors and the entire agro-food chain including other

departments and agencies with interest in the agro-food sector. The function talk was aimed at strengthening the National Food Security Agenda through ideas. Security Agenca trivolgin loess, views and suggestions put forth by industry players towards the direction of the agno-lood sector, especially in relation to food security in line with current needs One of the key points that Road death trought line list.

One or one key points that Ronald had brought up was that the reopening of the country's borders on April 1 would further boost its agro-food industry. There were restrictions

imposed on restaurants, cafés hotels, and other establishmer but with the reopening of the country's borders lockdown following the Covid-19 pandemic outbreak in the country, I believe

indirectly benefit from it.

At the same event, Ronald also presented dividends to the Sarawak State Fishermen's

Association (PENESA) amounting to RM192,032.10, as well as an allocation to the KUNITA Sportsfishing Project of the Salang Biru Area Fishermen's Association

amounting to RM50,000.
On Friday, Ronald made a trip to Batang Lupar Integrated Agricultural Area (IADA) for a tour of the Stumbin and Tanjung Bijat fice cultivation sites in Sn Aman, about 190km from here. He visited the Smart Paddy

Field Programme (Smart SBB) site where he described the programme as 'being expected to increase farmers' income up to 50 per cent through complete infrastructure facilities and farm mechanisation "Until March 2022, the Smart

SBB programme in Sarawak is being implemented under the supervision of the Batang Lupar IADA, in collaboration with Advansia (Sarawak) Sdn Bhd, involving an area of 60 hectares in L2 and L3 Tanjung Bijal, Sri Aman for the main season of 2021 and

off season of 2022.
The programme involves a total of 245 participants for both seasons, he said.

Ronald expressed his hope that more industry players, especially the 'syankat peneraju' (leading companies) under the Smart SBB programme, would comforward and bring new ideas and innovations so that such programmes could be developed not only for paddy, but also other

He also witnessed the exchange

memorandum of collaboration (MOC) documents between Mañ and Syarikat Padiberas Nasional Bhd (Bernas) for the operation of Stumbin Certified Paddy Seeds Production and Processing Centre

"It is also my hope that this strategic collaboration between Mañ and Bernas would make the paddy and the rice sub-sector in Sarawak more competitive along

the industry chain.

Mail also supports the aspirations and efforts of the Sarawak government fowards modernising the agricultural sector for the production of lucrative paddy for local consumption, and reducing dependence on rice imports," he said.

On Friday, Kiandee attended a dinner reception held at a hotel here, where he was cited to have said that a special committee would be established for regular official meetings for better cooperation between his ministry and Sarawak's Ministry of Modernisation of Agriculture and Regional Development (Manned) to lackle challenges in ensuring food

security

He said this was a result of discussions with Manred minister Dato Sri Dr Stephen Rundi Utom,

who was also present at the event.

"There is need for involvement and engagement between the ministry at federal and state levels. Such engagement is not just once, but we need to meet more often.
That is why we have come

to a decision to form a special

committee consisting of officers from Mañ and Manred. We will continue to work together in finding the best ways to ensure the country's food security," said Ronald.

The federal minister wrapped up his three-day working visit to Sarawak with a walkabout at the popular Medan Niaga Satok here yéslerday morning to inspect lhe progress of the ongoing upgrading works there.

It is stated that the market is currently undergoing renovation and improvement works carried out by Federal Agriculture Marketing Authority (Fama) and the Sarawak government

'The state government has, in fact, contributed RM7 million for the upgrading works on Satok Market, and this reflects the close working relationship between the state and

federal governments.
Fama will also be carrying out improvement works on the markets. located throughout Sarawak, with another RM7 million having been earmarked under the 12th Malaysia Plan (12MP) to upgrade 15 markets in the state.
Fama will continue to play its

Fama will continue to play its role as a marketing agency to support the agro-entrepreneurs in creating a friendly business environment for all stakeholders involved, said Ronald, as he pointed out that the renovation works on Medan Niaga Satok would be conducted in stages, with the multi-storey parking building and Block C scheduled to finish their construction soon.

Ronald: Improve rice self-sufficiency

KUCHING: Sarawak plays a crucial role in supporting the country's efforts in safeguarding its food security.

In stating this, Federal Minister of Agriculture and Food Industry Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee said judging from what he had observed during his recent visit to a paddy plantation in Batang Lupar, Sri Aman, much improvement was needed to enhance the food security in Sarawak.

In this respect, he said his ministry would seek to request for more funds meant to enhance the infrastructure development in Sarawak for the paddy industry to flourish, as well as to strengthen the nation's food supply chain. Efforts towards improving food security are on-going and the cooperation between the state and federal agencies and departments are vital in realising the country's objectives of protecting its food security.

"Efforts towards improving food security are on-going and the cooperation between the state and federal agencies and departments is vital in realising the country's objectives of protecting its food security," Ronald told reporters after a visit to Medan Niaga Satok in Petra Jaya here yesterday.

The visit concluded the federal minister's three-day visit to Sarawak, during which he inspected the status of numerous agriculture projects in the state and got to

identify weaknesses and issues that would require further improvements.

During the visit to a paddy plantation in Sri Aman on Friday, Ronald stated that the national rice self-sufficiency level was at 63 per cent, but Sarawak's was at 38 per cent.

In view of this, he stressed that immediate measures must be carried out to increase rice production in order to meet the target of 80 per cent for the national rice self-sufficiency level, and 60 per cent for

KUCHING: Agriculture and Food Industries Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee visited Medan Niaga Satok at Petra Jaya here to check the progress of ongoing upgrading works.

"This market is a big project officiated in 2013 and currently undergoing renovation and upgrading works carried out by Federal Agriculture Marketing Authority (Fama) and the state government," he said in a press conference after the visit.

He said works at the market will be completed in stages, with the multi-storey car park and Block C to be completed soon. He stated the state government had contributed RM7 million to the upgrading works, a reflection of close working relationship between the state and federal governments.

Ronald pointed out that Fama will also be carrying out improvement works at 15 markets throughout Sarawak with another RM7 million under the 12nd Malaysia Plan.

"Fama will continue its role as a marketing agency to support agropreneurs," he added.

In a press statement, Fama said Medan Niaga Satok was a RM46.6 million project built on 12.25-acres at Jalan Matang, Petra Jaya.

A total of 995 business lots at Block B for wet products, Block C for dry products, Block D plaza, and Block E food and beverages stalls generated sales of RM47.8 million last year.

Fama added that it has established many retail outlets to offer agriculture products and commodities directly to customers bypassing the middleman.

Among the retail outlets set up in cooperation with agropreneurs are Rural Transformation Centre, MyFarm outlet, My Best Buy, Agrobazaar K~ Shoppe Agrobazaar Online, and agriculture markets.

RM7m to upgrade 15 markets

KUCHING: A total of RM7 million has been allocated under the 12th Malaysia Plan for the upgrading of 15 markets throughout Sarawak.

Agriculture and Food Industries, Datuk Seri Ronald Kiandee, disclosed this after visiting Medan Niaga Satok (MNS) here yesterday.

He said the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (FAMA) and Ministry of Agriculture and Food Industries (MAFI) would continue efforts to contribute and improve business structures throughout the country including Sarawak.

"FAMA will continue to play its role as a marketing agency that not only helps traders and entrepreneurs but also creates a comfortable business environment for all parties," he added.

Kiandee at the same time also welcomed cooperation from the Sarawak government in contributing funds to improve the existing business infrastructure in the state.

He said the basic cost of the Medan Niaga Satok (MNS) project which was built on a 12.25 acres in Jalan Matang, Petra Jaya, is RM46.6 million.

"MNS has received an allocation of RM7 million from the Sarawak State government for development and upgrading works such as the construction of multi-storey car parks, upgrades in blocks B, C and D," he said. He explained that the project

He explained that the project will provide a market with a modern, clean, orderly and complete concept with the latest waste management system.

"MNS was built to replace the Satok Market which was becoming obsolete and no longer suitable due to drainage problems, dirty environment and traffic congestion," he said.

Apart from that, he shared that FAMA has developed many retail outlets aimed at strengthening the supply chain as well as increasing market opportunities (outlets) for direct sales of agricultural commodities and agricultural products to consumers, especially in urban and suburban areas.

"Through these outlets, the distribution chain can be shortened as well as the risk of market manipulation by middlemen reduced," he said. He added that there are 1,037 of these outlets throughout Malaysia.

Meanwhile, FAMA also developed marketing infrastructures such as the Rural Transformation Center (RTC) Program, MyFarm Outlet, Farmers 'Market, and Permanent Farmers' Market.

"In addition, various marketing and sales programmes and activities are held here such as the MyRakyat programme and Direct Sales from Farms as an initiative to help reduce the cost of living of the people.

"Close collaboration with the State Government will continue to ensure that MNS plays an important role in agro-food marketing in Sarawak," he said.
