## Jabatan Pertanian tidak terbabit urusan permit tapak perkhemahan

SHAH ALAM - Jabatan Pertanian menafikan dakwaan pihaknya memaklumkan tiada lesen tapak perkhemahan yang boleh dipohon oleh pengusaha Father's Organic Farm.

Jabatan Pertanian dalam satu kenyataan berkata, pihaknya tidak mempunyai autoriti untuk memberi permit, lesen atau khidmat nasihat kepada mana-mana pengusaha yang menyediakan tapak perkhemahan.

Menurut kenyataan itu, Jabatan Pertanian khususnya Pejabat Pertanian Daerah Hulu Selangor tidak pernah memberi ulasan atau berbincang berkenaan permit tapak perkhemahan atau sebagainya dengan pengusaha Father's Organic Farm.

"Ini kerana, perkara tersebut adalah di luar bidang kuasa Jabatan Pertanian.

"Kami hanya berperanan memberi khidmat nasihat berkaitan proses dan kaedah untuk mendapatkan pensijilan Skim Pensijilan Organik Malaysia (myOrganic) serta lawatan berkaitan proses tersebut di Father's Organic Farm," ujarnya pada Rabu.

Perkara itu dikeluarkan oleh jurucakap tapak perkhemahan Father's Organic Farm, Frankie Tan dalam sidang media yang diadakan di Kuala Lumpur pada 19 Disember 2022.

Pengusaha tapak perkhemahan Father's Organic Farm di Batang Kali, Selangor yang mengalami bencana tanah runtuh pada Jumaat lalu memaklumkan dia tidak dapat membuat permohonan mendapatkan lesen tapak perkhemahan kerana permit seperti itu tidak wujud.

Frankie Tan berkata, dia diberitahu oleh pelbagai agensi kerajaan termasuk jabatan pertanian bahawa tiada lesen sedemikian boleh dipohon oleh pengusaha tapak perkhemahan.

Tambah Jabatan Pertanian, pihaknya berfungsi untuk memberikan khidmat pengembangan pertanian dalam pengeluaran bahan makanan yang mencukupi, berkualiti dan selamat dimakan.

"Selain itu, kami turut menguatkuaskan akta-akta yang menjaga keselamatan, kualiti dan melindungi industri pertanian negara dari ancaman perosak dan penyakit serta memudahkan perdagangan antarabangsa," jelasnya.

## Jabatan Pertanian tidak terbabit dalam urusan permit tapak perkhemahan

KUALA LUMPUR: Jabatan Pertanian Malaysia (DOA) menegaskan pihaknya tidak terbabit langsung dalam sebarang perkara berkaitan [kelulusan permit tapak perkhemahan Father's Organic Farm](#) seperti yang didakwa oleh pengendalinya, Frankie Tan.

DOA dalam satu kenyataan menyebut, dakwaan itu tidak benar sama sekali dan memaklumkan, peranan DOA adalah hanya memberi khidmat nasihat berkaitan proses dan kaedah untuk mendapatkan pensijilan Skim Pensijilan Organik Malaysia (myOrganic) serta lawatan berkaitan proses pensijilan di tapak perkhemahan itu.

"DOA khususnya Pejabat Pertanian Daerah Hulu Selangor tidak pernah memberi ulasan atau berbincang dengan pengusaha Father's Organic Farm berkaitan permit tapak perkhemahan dan sebagainya kerana perkara itu adalah di luar bidang kuasa DOA.

"Selain itu, DOA tidak mempunyai kuasa untuk memberi permit, lesen atau khidmat nasihat kepada mana-mana pengusaha yang menyediakan tapak perkhemahan," menurut kenyataan itu.

Sebelum ini, Frankie dilaporkan berkata, pihaknya tidak dapat membuat permohonan mendapatkan lesen tapak perkhemahan kerana permit seperti itu tidak wujud.

Beliau berkata, perkara itu dimaklumkan oleh pelbagai agensi kerajaan, termasuk Jabatan Pertanian bahawa tiada lesen seumpama itu boleh dipohon oleh pengusaha tapak perkhemahan.

DOA menyebut, agensi itu hanya berfungsi untuk memberikan khidmat pengembangan pertanian dalam pengeluaran bahan makanan yang mencukupi, berkualiti dan selamat dimakan.

"Selain itu, DOA bertanggungjawab menguatkuasakan akta yang menjaga keselamatan, kualiti dan melindungi industri pertanian negara daripada ancaman perosak dan penyakit, serta memudahkan perdagangan antarabangsa," menurut kenyataan itu.

Pada 16 Disember lalu, berlaku insiden tanah runtuh sepanjang hampir 300 meter dari ketinggian 70 meter di tapak perkhemahan itu dan mengorbankan 26 nyawa setakat ini, manakala tujuh lagi mangsa masih hilang.

## [UPDATED] Agriculture Dept denies saying campsite licence not required

It refutes claim by Father's Organic Farm spokesman

**KUALA LUMPUR** – The Agriculture Department (DoA) said it had never told the Father's Organic Farm operators that it was not necessary for its managers to apply for campsite licences.

In refuting a statement made by campsite spokesman Frankie Tan, the department said it had never discussed the matter with the operators, adding that it only advised the farm to obtain the Malaysian Organic Certification Scheme certification.

"The DoA, especially the Hulu Selangor district Agriculture office, has never provided any explanation or discussed the matters such as campsite operations with the operators of Father's Organic Farm as the matter was outside the DoA's jurisdiction," it said, in a statement.

"Apart from that, the DoA does not have the authority to give permits, licences, or advice to any operators that offer campsites."

The department insisted that its role is to provide agricultural development services in food safety and security, apart from quality control, adding that it also protects the country's agriculture industry from the threat of pests and diseases, while also facilitating international trade.

Yesterday, Tan claimed that various government entities, such as the DoA, had told him it was unnecessary for campsite managers to apply for site licences.

Stressing that he was unaware of the campsite section being classified as a high-risk area, he asserted that the "crush of soil" from the landslide had begun on "government land" about 2-3km from the campsite.

Following the tragic landslide on December 16 – which saw a total of 94 victims, seven of which are still missing – Local Government Development Minister Nga Kor Ming said that the campsite in Batang Kali was operating without a licence from the Hulu Selangor District Council.

He added that the operators involved could face up to three years in prison and a maximum fine of RM50,000.

The search-and-rescue operation at the scene of the landslide was halted around 2.30pm today due to rain as search efforts entered their sixth day.

Earlier today, Selangor's Local Government, Public Transport, and New Village Development executive councillor Ng Sze Han said the state government was formulating clear regulations on camping activities following the tragedy.

In a press conference today, Ng said while businesses in the state are properly managed through their licence apart from other regulations, outdoor activities – such as camping or fishing – are considered as sub-categories and not governed by specific terms and conditions.

Ng said proper regulations would mandate operators to comply with terms and conditions and ensure the safety of their patrons.

It was also reported earlier that police had called up the campsite operator and two of its workers to assist in probes into the landslide tragedy.

The earthfall, measuring nearly 300m in length and 70m in height, had hit the campsite located in a canyon below the Batang-Gohtong Jaya road here around 2.42am on Friday.

The operators subsequently took to Facebook to express their condolences over the incident, saying they "humbly bow" to everyone affected. – The Vibes, December 21, 2022

## Batang Kali landslide: We never said camping licenses are not needed, says Agriculture Dept

PETALING JAYA: The Agriculture Department has denied having discussions with Father's Organic Farm operators on campsite operations as it does not have the authority on the matter.

It said the department, specifically the Hulu Selangor Agriculture Office, never held discussions with Father's Organic Farm operators on the matter following media reports quoting the camping site's spokesman saying that government entities, including the Agriculture Department, had mentioned it was unnecessary for campsite managers to apply for such licences.

"This is false. The Agriculture Department only advised Father's Organic Farm on processes to obtain an agricultural certificate, while also conducting site visits there."

"The Agriculture Department also does not have the authority to issue permits, licences or advice for campsite operations," it said in a statement on Wednesday (Dec 21).

In a press conference on Tuesday (Dec 20), Father's Organic Farm spokesperson Frankie Tan said they had attempted to apply for a campsite permit but were told by several government authorities, including the Agriculture Department, that it was not necessary.

A landslide, which occurred along the Batang Kali-Genting Highlands stretch in the wee hours of Dec 16 hit Father's Organic Farm, leaving 26 dead with seven victims yet to be found.

Search operations at the site are currently in its sixth day, with operations temporarily halted on Wednesday evening due to continuous rain.

Eligible customers, he said, can apply for the facilities offered through the form provided on Agrobank's website.



# Pastikan kualiti, harga telur import terjamin

**TELUR** import perlu dijual pada harga yang tidak membebankan peniaga dan pengguna.



**PETALING JAYA:** Langkah kerajaan untuk mengimport telur ayam bukan penyelesaian jangka panjang yang berdaya maju mendangkan secara umumnya ia lebih mahal selain kualitinya yang mudah rosak.

Bercakap kepada Utusan Malaysia, Presiden Gabungan Persatuan Peniaga dan Peniaga Malaysia, Datuk Seri Rosli Sulaiman berkata, jika harga telur import dijual pada harga yang mahal, ia kekal menyulitkan peniaga dan pengguna.

Selain itu, katanya, umum tahu telur sangat mudah rosak jika disimpan dalam tempoh lama dan sekiranya diimport ia akan disimpan dalam tempoh beberapa hari dan akhirnya telur yang sampai kepada peniaga

diragui kualitiinya.  
“Imi sebenarnya langkah yang tidak praktikal, telur pun kita kena import tetapi, kita tiada pilihan dan terpaksa import untuk memastikan rakyat negara ini mendapat bekalan untuk kegunaan harian termasuk para peniaga.”

“Cuma, apa yang kena lihat jalah soal harga dan kualiti telur...Kita tidak mahu telur yang sampai sudah tiada kualiti dan rosak akibat proses import yang lama. Jadi, bagi saya, imi bukanlah satu kaedah yang boleh dibuat secara berterusan.

“Kerajaan kena fikirkan untuk kita bina semula industri telur ini, biar ada bekalan dalam negara oleh penternak kita. Apa yang kurang sebelum ini kita baiki

demikian memastikan kita tidak terputus bekalan seperti sekarang,” katanya ketika dihubungi. Semalam, Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim berkata, kerajaan akan mengimpor sekurang-kurangnya dua hingga 10 juta biji telur sehingga mulai Khamis ini untuk menampung keperluan dan permintaan pasarannya bagi tujuan mengawal harganya.

“Kita sudah buat perubahan dengan memberikan import bermula pada 15 Disember de-

ngan 100,000 biji telur (import)

dan mulai 22 Disember, dua

hingga 10 juta biji telur sehari

akan dibawa masuk sehingga

Pelanggan kecewa barang keperluan itu cepat habis

# Telur, minyak masak peket masih kurang

**JOHOR BAHRU** – Orang ramai di negeri ini keliru dengan kenyataan pihak berkuasa yang memaklumkan barang keperluan seperti telur dan minyak peket bersubsidi telah pulih, sedangkan hakikatnya ia masih sukar diperoleh.

Rata-rata mereka memaklumkan, biarpun mencari di beberapa kedai, namun kedua-dua barang keperluan itu tiada di rak kedai, kalau adapun dalam kuantiti sedikit.

Seorang pengguna, Siti Maishara Supaid, 37, berkata, dia sendiri mengalami kesukaran untuk mendapatkan bekalan telur dan minyak masak peket bersubsidi setiap kali ke kedai berhampiran rumahnya.

Katanya, dia masih keliru dengan keadaan itu kerana sebelum

ini, pihak berkuasa memaklumkan bekalananya telah pulih.

“Sukar untuk mendapat bekalan telur serta minyak peket khususnya di kawasan perumahan melibatkan kedai-kedai runcit atau pasar raya kecil.

“Hanya selepas beberapa kali berkunjung ke kedai, baru jumpa. Realitinya ia masih sukar diperoleh,” katanya di sini semalam.

Seorang lagi pengguna, Mohd. Badrull Hisyam Adam, 32, memberitahu, dia mengurangkan penggunaan telur ayam dalam menu harian keluarga kerana bekalan sukar diperoleh.

“Sudah lama rasanya saya tidak membelinya, sebaliknya kini saya beli minyak masak botol untuk kegunaan harian,” ujarnya.

Tinjauan yang dibuat di beberapa premis perniagaan di sini mendapati, bekalan kedua-dua

barang itu masih sukar diperoleh, terutamanya pada waktu petang dan malam.

Dalam pada itu, Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) Johor sentiasa membuat pemeriksaan bekalan barang keperluan pengguna bagi memantau kedudukan bekalan serta kenaikan harga.

Pengaruhnya, Mohd. Hairul Anuar Bohro berkata, seramai 200 anggota penguat kuasa ditugaskan untuk menjalankan pemantauan dan pemeriksaan supaya bekalan barang keperluan harian mencukupi.

“Kami ambil maklum aduan pengguna tentang bekalan serta kenaikan harga, khususnya melibatkan telur ayam dan minyak masak peket di lokasi tumpuan ramai seperti pasar awam dan pasar basah,” katanya.

# Egg shortage in one-third of outlets in Selangor

**KAPAR:** About 40 out of 110 premises in Selangor were found to be facing a shortage of eggs after enforcement officers carried out the four-day statewide Op Terjah.

Selangor Domestic Trade and Cost of Living director Mohd Zuhairi Mat Radey said three premises were found to have a shortage of chickens while 26 premises lacked a supply of subsidised cooking oil.

"Only one outlet had no stock of cooking oil.

"We found that the supply of eggs and cooking oil was mostly short in Petaling Jaya.

"However, the supply of basic necessities like bottled cooking oil and flour is stable," he told reporters when met at a supermarket here yesterday, Bernama reported.

Mohd Zuhairi said inspections were carried out in stages and targeted premises selling basic necessities such as markets, mini markets, retail stores, small hawker stalls and eateries.

He said they would utilise a traffic light mechanism to monitor the supply of basic necessities such as chicken, chicken eggs and cooking oil at these premises.

"This system uses the green code (sufficient supply), yellow (insufficient supply) and red (no supply) to assist us in taking comprehensive action and ensure that the supply of necessities is not affected," he said.
