Dua bot nelayan Myanmar ditahan

AGENSI Penguatkuasaan Maritim Malaysia (Maritim Malaysia) Kemaman menahan dua bot nelayan asing bersama empat nelayan warga Myanmar termasuk tekong kerana mencerooboh perairan Kerteh dekat sini pagi semalam.

Pengarah Zon Maritim Kemaman, Komander Maritim Rashidilhadi Abd. Rashid berkata, sebelum itu pihaknya menerima maklumat orang awam mengenai aktiviti penangkapan ikan oleh nelayan pantai asing terbabit.

Menurutnya, berikutan itu, sebuah bot peronda ditugaskan membuat tinjauan ke kawasan tersebut dan mendapati dua bot fiber kendalian warga My-

anmar yang merupakan pemegang kad Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu Bagi Pelarian (UNHCR) giat menjalankan aktiviti penangkapan ikan kira-kira sembilan kilometer dari Pantai Kerteh.

Beliau berkata, empat nelayan berusia 20 hingga 25 tahun itu ditangkap kira-kira pukul 10 pagi semalam sebelum dibawa ke Jeti Zon Maritim Kemaman untuk siasatan lanjut.

"Kes ini juga akan disiasat di bawah Akta Perikanan 1985 kerana mereka gagal mempamerkan lesen dan permit kebenaran menangkap ikan daripada Jabatan Perikanan Malaysia.

"Hasil pemeriksaan pihak kami mendapati nilai rampasan dianggarkan RM60,000 termasuk nilai

dua buah bot dan juga peralatan menangkap ikan," katanya kepada *Utusan Malaysia* di sini hari ini.

Rashidilhadi berka-ta, Maritim Negeri Terengganu dan Zon Maritim Kemaman akan terus memper-tingkatkan kawalan keselamatan dan pen-guatkuasaan undang-

undang maritim bagi memas-tikan undang-undang dipatuhi selain keselamatan pengguna maritim di perairan Malaysia sentiasa terjaga.

Sehubungan itu, beliau me-minta kerjasama orang ramai membantu menangani sebarang kesalahan atau jenayah di perai-ran negara dengan menghubungi talian MERS 999 atau Zon Mar-itim Kemaman 09-8582825.

■ Nelayan Vietnam agresif cuba lolos diri rempuh KM Pekan

Tok Bali, jam 2.40 petang, Selasa lalu.
Pemangku Pengarah APMM Kelantan, Komander Maritim Ismail Hamzah berkata, terdahulu KM Pekan berjaya memintas dan menahan sebuah bot nelayan Vietnam pada kedudukan 92 batu nautika dari Kuala Tok Bali pada jam 1.12 tengah hari.

“Pada masa sama KM Pekan mengesan bot

berkenaan berada pada kedudukan berhampiran dan terus merapati untuk melakukan pengegedahan serta pemeriksaan.
“Namun kru bot membuang tali dan pukat ke laut. Tujuan mereka adalah supaya peralatan itu terlekat pada kipas dan menghalang pergerakan KM Pekan.
“Namun atas pengalaman kru KM Pekan taktik itu tidak berhasil. Tekong juga

melakukan pergerakan berbahaya hingga bot dikendalikan tersangkut pada sisi KM Pekan, tetapi bot berkenaan berjaya dipintas akhirnya,” katanya pada sidang media di Pekarangan Pejabat APMM Tok Bali di sini, semalam.

Katanya, hasil pemeriksaan dilakukan pihaknya tidak menolak kemungkinan kru bot kedua yang bertindak agresif membuang alat navigasi Sistem Pengesanan Global (GPS) ke laut untuk menghilangkan bukti kedudukan bot dalam

Tukar sasaran ke perairan Sabah, Sarawak

Pasir Puteh: Pencembobohan nelayan asing terutama warga Vietnam dilihat menumpukan sasaran ke perairan Sabah dan Sarawak selepas penguatkuasaan perairan di Kelantan semakin ketat.

Pemangku Pengarah Maritim Negeri Kelantan, Komander Maritim Ismail Hamzah berkata, operasi Agensi Penguatkuasaan Maritim Malaysia (APMM) yang sering membuat tangkapan besar-besaran dan kerjasama dengan Polis Marin Thailand menyebabkan nelayan waga Vietnam kini mengubah aktiviti tangkapan ikan ke dua negeri berkenaan.

Katanya, pencembobohan ke atas perairan negara sangat serius kerana aktiviti tangkapan ikan di dalam perairan negara dilakukan hampir setiap hari.

"Kerakusan nelayan ini menangkap ikan dengan cara pukat tunda menyebabkan perairan negara mereka sudah tidak ada lagi hasil laur.

"Ini menyebabkan ratusan bot mereka terbiar dan mula mengaut hasil di perairan negara kita.

malah sekarang sudah bergerak ke perairan Sabah dan Sarawak selepas banyak aktiviti mereka terjejas dengan adanya Op Naga," katanya ketika ditemui di pejabat Agensi Penguatkuasaan Maritim Malaysia (APMM), Tok Ball di sini, semalam.

Beliau berkata, nelayan Vietnam turut bergerak lebih jauh ke Indonesia, Filipina, China dan Australia.

Katanya, penguatkuasaan pelbagai pihak harus diperketat memandangkan nelayan asing seolah-olah tidak serik melakukan kesalahan kerana kompaun dan wang jaminan dikenakan mudah dibayar pemilik bot atau tauke mereka.

"Jika sabit kesalahan, bot akan disita namun tekgong dan awak-awak akan dibebaskan dengan jaminan RM30,000 hingga RM60,000 yang sanggup dibayar pemilik.

"Sejak awal tahun ini kita lihat aktiviti pencembobohan nelayan asing dah semakin kurang di perairan Kelantan, ini hasil operasi yang dilaksanakan," katanya.

"Beliau berkata, pihaknya merampas kedua-dua bot berkenaan, peralatan menangkap ikan, hasil tangkapan pelbagai spesies dan sotong kering seberat 60 kilogram dianggarkan bernilai RM1.5 juta.

Ismail berkata, semakan dilakukan mendapati 21 warganegara asing ditahan membabitkan dua tekong dan kru yang ditangkap berusia antara 17 hingga 55 tahun.

"Pemeriksaan pada bot pertama membawa kepada tangkapan seorang tekong dan dua kru tidak memiliki dokumen pengenalan diri yang sah.

"Sementara pemeriksaan di bot kedua pula kami menahan seorang tekong dan kru. Semakan mendapati hanya empat daripada mereka termasuk tekong memiliki dokumen



pengenalan diri," katanya.

Jelasnya, dua bot berkenaan bersama tekong dan kru dibawa ke Jeti APMM di Tok Ball untuk siasatan lanjut dan bagi

membantu siasatan mengikut Akta Perikanan 1985.

Beliau berkata, kejayaan itu menjadikan tangkapan menerusi Op Naga

meningkat kepada 62 dengan 49 adalah bot nelayan Vietnam, dua bot Thailand dan 11 bot nelayan tempatan dalam tempoh 79 hari operasi dilaksanakan.

Apa saja bentuk rantaian kegiatan mencuri hasil sumber laut perlu diumpuhkan segera bagi mengembalikan semula hak nelayan dan pengguna Malaysia.

Timbalan Presiden Gabungan Persatuan-Persatuan Pengguna Malaysia (Pomca), Mohd Yusof Abdul Rahman berkata, pihak berkuasa berkaitan perlu menangani isu berkenaan dengan lebih tegas menggunakan peruntukan perundangan.

Bellau berkata, jika pihak berkuasa tidak dapat membantah kegiatan nelayan asing ini, tidak mustahil ikan diimport daripada hasil tangkapan perairan Malaysia sendiri.

"Kesannya berangkai sebab itu sepatutnya pihak berkuasa perlu bertindak segera kegiatan berleluasa ini dan siasat betul-betul serta ambil tindakan tegas kepada mana-mana pihak atau nelayan tempatan yang bersekeongkol," katanya.

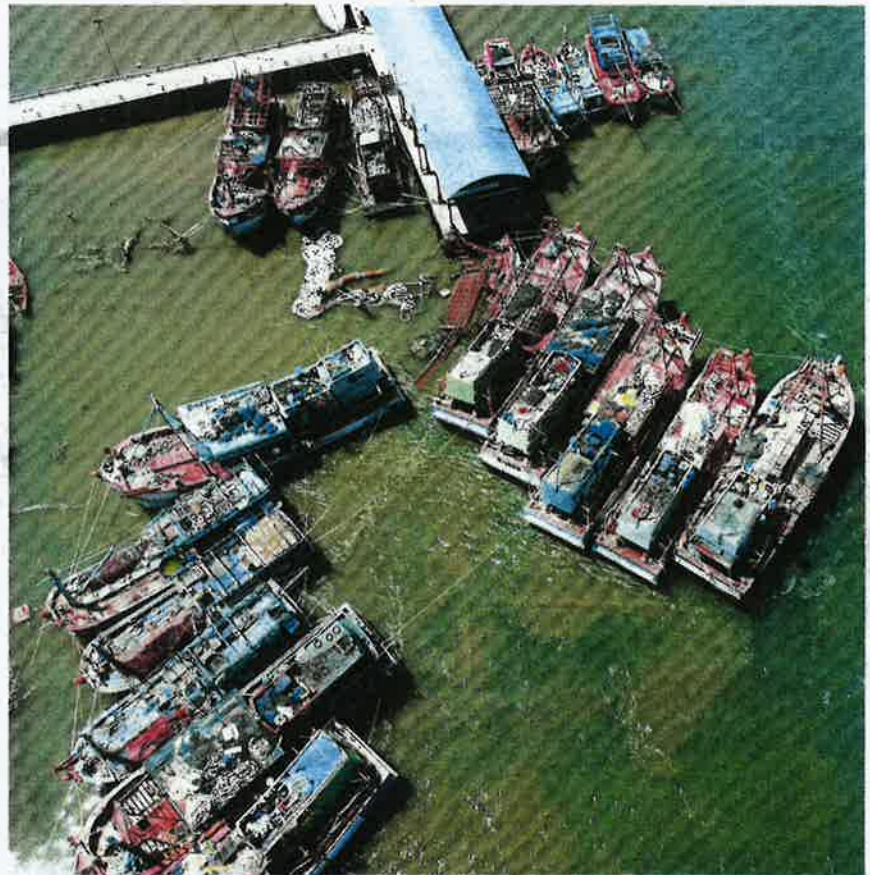

"Namun apabila tiba di lokasi aktiviti itu tidak ada, bot dilaporkan sudah lepas. Mereka seakan-akan mengetahui kehadiran pihak berkuasa.

"Kami tidak menolak kemungkinan pengusaha bot berkenaan mengupah penduduk di penempatan nelayan yang berdekatan untuk memantau jeti dan pergerakan kapal melakukan rondaan.

Kuala Lumpur: Jabatan Perikanan Malaysia (DOF) sedia bekerjasama dengan Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM) bagi menanganai salah laku membabitkan unsur penyelewengan termasuk membabitkan isu berkaitan pencero-bohan nelayan Vietnam.

Ketua Pengarahnya Daruk Munir Mohd Nawi berkata, isu dibangkitkan lesen al-baba dan bot klon nelayan Vietnam dilaporkan Harian Metro banyak menjurus kepada aspek penguatkuasaan.

"Namun kami perlu menyiasat perkara ini dengan lebih lanjut, berdasarkan aduan DOF akan siasat sama ada benar bot itu bot asing

Katanya, semua prosedur operasi standard (SOP) diteliti semula selain penguat-

kuasaan dan naziran dipertingkatkan bagi menanganai isu berkaitan pencero-bohan nelayan asing.

"SOP perolehan vesel luar negara dan SOP pengeluaran permit laut dalam diteliti semula. Malah, penyelarasan agensi penguatkuasaan dan naziran akan dipertingkatkan lagi," katanya.

Munir berkata, bermula

2011 sebanyak 172 daripada 353 lesen dikeluarkan sudah dibatalkan kerana tidak mematuhi syarat permohonan.

Menurutnya, DOF melaksanakan langkah pengurusan mampan dalam skop lebih meluas berdasarkan semua laporan aktiviti yang memberi kesan kemerosotan kepada sumber perikanan negara.

- **Crowdfunding** a possible source for agricultural entrepreneurs
- **AgroBazaar** online aims to boost sales of fresh and processed foods for local agriculture-based entrepreneurs



V. Sanjugtha

The Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (FAMA) is busy modernising and re-engineering its processes along the value chain as it strives to create better opportunities and higher income potential for farmers while producing better quality food at more affordable prices.

Tall order? Not for the new chairman, Ishak Ismail, at the helm. Determined to shed the traditional image of FAMA, he is revving its engines as he leverages on the sharing economy and Internet of Things to make farm-to-table produce at a fraction of the expected cost.

A popular figure in the property industry, he was appointed FAMA chairman last November, largely due to his extensive experience and expertise in marketing.

Ishak tells *FocusM* that he visualises a future for the food industry that is fuelled by a sustainable and continuous supply while ensuring farmers' profit margins are boosted without affecting consumer prices, thus satisfying a key pillar of the agency, to elevate the income level of the nation's agricultural providers.

FAMA is the only marketing agency for agri-based products in the country, encompassing fresh products as well as processed foods.

"Our role is to ensure that the products can access the market. We are also duty bound to ensure that farmers have access to funds within the authority.

"We are key to educating and regulating the entrepreneurs to reach the best of standards commensurate with FAMA's vision," Ishak explains.

Availability of funds is one of the biggest challenges entrepreneurs face, to enhance access to funds, Ishak spearheaded talks with Agribank for FAMA to guarantee a farmer's crop value.

"We signed a forward agreement with our farmers, guaranteeing a floor price for their crops. This guarantee" is now accepted by the banks as a form of collateral to provide them with loans," he says.

But Ishak is also looking at the growing trend of crowdfunding as a resource for farmers. He reveals that plans are afoot to draw up funding options for entrepreneurs with some

crowdfunding platforms.

FAMA achieved sales to the tune of RM2.8 billion last year and projects a 6% growth to RM2.9 billion this year. Its biggest contribution was its one-stop centre programme under the Rural Transformation Centre (RTC), with RTC Kluantan scoring sales of RM700 million last year.

Its fresh produce marketing attracted purchases worth RM1.1 million from January to August last year while its entrepreneur retail initiative K-Shoppe raked in RM1.2 million in the same period.

FAMA's mobile retail unit, Karivan, took in approximately RM20.2 million of sales from January to August last year, and its farm outlets contributed RM25.9 million in sales in the same period.

FAMA is "responsible" for ensuring that consumers are able to access the products at fair and reasonable prices, which are at least 2% to 3% below the prices of public markets.

Ishak notes that the penetration of most these distribution outlets is still low and believes substantial sales growth can be achieved with increased marketing efforts that create more outlets to channel produce directly from the farm to the consumers.

"From the time I stepped in, I see this as one of the core functions of FAMA," says Ishak, who is also the founder and managing director of IVC Global, a property consultancy, estate agency and property management company that has been in the market for over a decade.

Drawing parallels with his

role in the estate agency, Ishak points out that marketing is the key to the success of any industry.

"Only the product differs, but when we learn about property, we are taught all the marketing tricks to market and sell a product," he reveals.

Ishak is a strong advocate of technology and he believes the way forward for FAMA is to fully utilise technology as it plays its initiatives in line with the five core pillars of its parent, the Ministry of Agriculture (MoA).

- Modernise and increase agricultural output
- Increase private investment
- Ensure that all the agricultural providers are well compensated
- Improve the ecosystem of the agriculture industry
- Strengthen the organisational structure of such agency and department under the MoA

Technology is key

FAMA's online portal, AgroBazaar Online, currently has a low penetration rate. Sales via this portal from January to August last year was only RM680,000.

Ishak sees the need to hop onto the Internet of Things (IoT) as FAMA plans to grow AgroBazaar Online into becoming the go-to platform for all fresh and processed produce.

"We have 2,700 outlets across the country, but they are all offline. People are not aware of AgroBazaar's online platform," he laments, acknowledging that its potential is big.

According to Ishak, FAMA has about 10,000 entrepreneurs but only about 1,800 have stock keeping units (SKU) online. To encourage online registrants, FAMA is offering free registration for more SKUs to be offered on the online platform.

But this is only one piece of the puzzle. The next hurdle in cementing an online presence is the delivery channel.

FAMA needs sufficient pick-up points or a sound delivery system to be viewed seriously as a go-to grocery provider.

"FAMA has ample resources in the 270 Pasar Tani nationwide and if we ramp up the registrants from these entrepreneurs and get them to join the online portal, then they not only widen the AgroBazaar offering but also serve as our additional pick-up points," Ishak observes.

This creates the next generation of shopping with consumers going online to select their produce and have them either delivered to their home or to be picked up at designated locations nationwide.

Ishak takes his vision a step further with the intention to create FAMA's own delivery system, *Fast Express*.

Ranking on MYAgribusiness (Agriculture) to include Entrepreneurs' Clubs members, comprising students and ex-students of local institutions of higher learning, FAMA intends to offer them an additional source of income by setting up its delivery network, not unlike established

or other home-delivery services. "Currently, many of them are part of our dropship agents (manufacturers or wholesale distributors who produce directly to customers, but sellers) but we would like to (urge them to) join Tani Express."

"Then, delivery becomes another area where they can improve their source of income," Ishak reveals.

Unlocking idle land

Lack of a continuous and sustainable supply of produce seems to be hindering the income potential and obscuring the attractiveness of the agriculture industry.

"There is a lot of state land that is not developed all over the country. So, I have taken the initiative to request the state authorities for waqaf and idle land to be developed," Ishak says.

FAMA currently runs a programme dubbed Permanent Food Production Park (PKPM) where farmers work on contract. This helps increase the earning potential of the farmers by providing an avenue to cultivate on a larger scale.

However, there are two points of contention: Price and mismatch of supply and demand in the market.

According to Ishak, FAMA has a forward agreement with the farmers to purchase their produce at a floor price. If the market price is higher, that is what the farmers get.

"The problem is that the system does not lock them in, to sell to FAMA only. So, if there is a buyer offering a higher price, FAMA then faces a disruption in supply to our consumers," he explains.

Another challenge is when the producer is below the quality expectation of the market, FAMA is then tasked to push a product that the market does not want, and this reduces the farmers' profit margin.

In view of such hurdles, Ishak believes that the way forward would be for FAMA to be able to control and manage the system, steering it to meet market demands.

Hence, the new system will shift the reins to FAMA in steering the direction of business for each plot of land. FAMA will dictate what is to be planted where to ensure market demands are met, thus ensuring a better profit margin.

"We will station our officers to ensure that the farmers abide by the requirements. We need to be strict on this and, if need be, farmers who do not comply with our standards will be terminated from the scheme," Ishak stresses.

Big data to fuel big changes

FAMA's forward-thinking chairman says data is the key that unlocks a world of information in

efficiency in operations.

With the world abuzz on big data and block chain technology, he is rethinking strategies to utilise the available resources to modernise and streamline FAMA's operations to ensure that food produce reach consumers efficiently while farmers are well compensated.

Ishak saw a huge wasted opportunity when supply missed regional demand. FAMA was constantly plagued with grumblings of farmers turning out products that did not meet the market's demand at that point in time.

"Therefore, there is over-supply, and when this happens prices

drop," he explains, reminding that FAMA is also responsible for ensuring that farmers have a healthy income.

The problem lies in the fragmented information held by various agencies. While FAMA has sufficient data on demand preferences and trends from its 2,700 outlets nationwide, the supply data is held by various agencies under the Agriculture Department.

"What we intend to do is create an interactive programme that will frame the existing supply and demand information with accuracy and reflects the most current demand trends in the market," Ishak points out.

He reveals that the necessary software is being developed - Supply - Demand - Virtual Information 2.0 (SDVI) will leverage on the IoT using block chain technology to create a more interactive experience that will link producers, consumers and wholesalers with increased transparency, subscribing to the principle of a market-driven approach to pricing.

Reaching consumers

As FAMA re-engineers the age-old supply chain in the agriculture industry, crucial to the successful rolling out of its new and improved initiatives is the need for a robust communications

channel and an effective distribution channel.

To bridge this gap in the market, Ishak breaks the boundaries of convention as he aims to create FAMA's own media division which will focus on disseminating information on all its programmes and initiatives in a timely manner.

"We aim to create FAMA TV, similar to the online news channels today. But we will focus on FAMA-specific news so that the traders, wholesalers and consumers know where to access current information such as pricing, location of pasar tani and who to go to if a farmer wants to sell his produce," he explains.

At present, information is disseminated largely through its own marketing initiatives on a smaller scale and through third party channels like Bernama TV and TV1.

Creating its own media channel will reduce dependency on third party channels where content is not within FAMA's control, and Ishak notes that many initiatives have not achieved the desired outcome due to poor communication and marketing information.

Ishak sees the need to educate and enlighten the public through an initiative like FAMA TV which will be easily accessible on mobile phones.

At present, to know the price of products at all pasar tani, a consumer can access an app called Goltasar Tani but it does not capture the entire spectrum of the marketing funnel.

Providing the information is only one aspect of the value chain. Moving on, FAMA needs to ensure that the products are easily available to consumers.

To meet this challenge, FAMA is building its first Agro Mall along the Damansara-Puchong Highway.

The BMR unit project will see the upgrading of FAMA's existing structure on a 2.5ha plot of land to incorporate a second floor for the sale of processed products.

FAMA seeks changes to its Act to do its job better

STEPPING into a new role and helming a public sector agriculture-based agency, property man Ishak Ismail realised he had to first tie up the loose ends. As the government's sole marketing arm for all agriculture-based products, the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (FAMA) must have clout over all marketing activities of all the commodities in the sector.

However, he realised that the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority Act of 1965, now no longer provides FAMA with full marketing control for certain commodities.

For instance, all fish products, from production to market, are managed by the Fisheries Department, as with rubber and oil palm (Primary Industries Ministry) and poultry and cattle (Veterinary Department). FAMA only handles the marketing of certain produce such as horticulture, floriculture and herbs.

According to Ishak, the weakness from lack

of centralised control arises when there are issues or challenges in a particular industry.

Ultimately, an issue that is related to marketing is channelled back to FAMA, regardless of which agency handles it.

"For example, many quarters were questioning the recent rise in egg prices. Although the marketing aspects are not handled by FAMA, consumers are still turning to us for answers," he explains.

Ishak took the first step in drawing up a list of amendments to the Act necessary for FAMA to function effectively, submitting the first draft to the Agriculture Ministry.

"The ministry has asked us to re-look at some of the proposed amendments, so we need to engage all the relevant departments and agencies for their opinion, before we proceed further," he adds.

Three main amendments are being sought. One is to bring back the core functions of

FAMA in order to facilitate the smooth and coordinated planning of all marketing activities for all commodities.

Another is to grant FAMA the formal jurisdiction to register all farmers, marketers and those along the supply chain in order to capture data for future initiatives and programmes.

The third amendment is to provide its regulatory officers with enforcement powers during inspections of grading, labelling and packaging (GAP) for products.

"Our officers need the power to ensure that there is proper compliance and application of GAP standards so we can identify products that should not be sold to consumers such as the recent instance of Vietnam chillies with high pesticide content," he explains.

Ishak explains that these amendments are also necessary to enable FAMA extend its jurisdiction to the Sabah and Sarawak markets. The current law restricts it to the peninsula.

Kangar: Agensi Penguatkuasaan Maritim Malaysia (Maritim Malaysia) Zon Kuala Perlis mengesan segelintir penduduk kampung nelayan di Kuala Perlis, menjadi dalang membocorkan maklumat berkaitan operasi rutin agensi itu kepada nelayan asing.

Pengarah Maritim Zon Kuala Perlis, Komander (Maritim) Nurulazme Zakariah, berkata ini berikutan pihaknya mengesan beberapa rumah di petempatan nelayan dilihat dalam keadaan mencurigakan.

Menurutnya, penduduk di petempatan terbabit yang terdiri daripada bekas tekong bot dipercayai menjadi tonto kepada bot haram dan penangkap ikan dari negara jiran.

"Kita sering memantau perairan negara setiap kali menerima maklumat daripada nelayan tempatan berhubung pencerobohan bot haram, namun aktiviti itu seakan lesap setiap kali kita tiba di lokasi kejadian.

"Mereka seakan mengetahui kehadiran pihak berkuasa dan saya percaya pengusaha bot haram ini mengupah penduduk di petempatan nelayan yang berdekatan dengan jeti pihak kami untuk memantau rutin rondaan kami.

"Berdasarkan risikan pihak kami, mereka yang diupah sebagai tonto ini menerima bayaran antara ribuan sehingga ratusan ribu ringgit setahun," katanya ketika ditemui di pejabatnya di sini, semalam.

Mengulas lanjut, Nurulazme berkata pihaknya turut menemui beberapa petunjuk mengenai dakwaan bahawa penduduk setempat di perkampungan nelayan yang terbabit menjadi tonto kepada bot asing.

Kita sering memantau perairan negara setiap kali menerima maklumat daripada nelayan tempatan berhubung pencerobohan bot haram, namun aktiviti itu seakan lesap setiap kali kita tiba di lokasi kejadian.

"Ini berdasarkan tingkah laku yang mencurigakan oleh penghuni di rumah terapung berkenaan setiap kali melihat bot rondaan APM keluar daripada jeti.

sini semalam.

Menurut Tina, harga pasaran eksport durian Musang King ke luar negara melonjak melebihi RM100 sekilogram.

Katanya, bagi pasaran tempatan buah tersebut dijual antara RM30 hingga RM50 sekilogram bergantung kepada kualiti.

Tina berkata, dia telah mengusahakan kebun di kawasan seluas 10 hektar di Kampung Pulau di sini sejak lebih 20 tahun lalu.

Jelasnya, selain boleh menikmati keenakan raja buah itu di kebunnya, pelanggan juga boleh membeli buah tersebut di gerai jualan berhampiran rumahnya di Kampung Batu Papan 2 di sini.

"Durian jenis udang merah pula warnanya unik iaitu oren kemerahan dan rasanya agak pahit lemak dan manis," katanya.

rengganu.

Anak sulung daripada lima beradik itu berkata, dia telah berkecimpung dalam perniagaan itu sejak berusia 21 tahun dan kini sudah hampir empat tahun di bawah bimbingan Fama dengan mempunyai 12 pekerja.

Memulakan perniagaan dengan modal antara RM20,000 hingga RM30,000 usahawan muda itu mampu menjana keuntungan sebanyak RM7,000 hingga RM10,000 sehari.

"Saya berani ambil risiko dan berani melabur untuk beri durian yang terbaik dengan harga yang terbaik kepada orang ramai terutama kepada penggemar raja buah ini," katanya yang beroperasi di tepi pagar Lapangan Terbang Sultan Mahmud, Kuala Nerus.

Banking on kelulut bees and Musang King

KUNAK: Diversity and perseverance are the main elements to sustain a smallholder's progress in the agricultural sector.

Noting the current gloomy commodity price for oil palm, Eyuki Upi @ Joge, an entrepreneur here, had used a portion of his land to plant Musang King durians.

"This is a trial to see whether the crop would produce good results as Musang King is now allowed to be exported apart from being sold locally," he said, while adding that currently the fruit's market price is higher than any other fruits.

"By planting them here, I am confident that it would be easier for Musang King fans to get their supplies."

At the moment, some five acres of his farmland were planted with 160 trees of Musang King durian.

"The trees are now 10-month old and it grew well here as the weather is suitable for them."

Eyuki who had also received the State Most Successful Smallholder Award previously, said many benefits can be obtained through experience sharing with other successful smallholders.

"To succeed in any industry, we have to

make an effort to give it a try first.

"The agricultural sector has its ups and downs, and that is why we have to be brave to diversify our products - do not rely on a

single product," he said.

Aside from Musang King durian, he still paid much attention to his 48-acre oil palm plantation.

"I would expand the area for my Musang King plantation into 10 acres if it yields positive result in two years' time," he said.

Meanwhile, Kelulut bee farming is capable of generating additional income for those who are keen.

A Kelulut bee farmer at Kg Skim Cocos, Rosley Ulemus, said he started this venture since last September, using the vacant space at the back of his house.

Today he is enjoying the harvest of his Kelulut honey which he packed himself using a brand name Bossley.

He said although initially he did not have any skill or knowledge about the venture, he started by learning from other

people's success and using his own pocket money without assistance from any agency.

"It was quite challenging at first. Now, my long-term plan is to market my product throughout Sabah and outside the State," he said, adding presently he sell to family members and friends as well as others in Kunak, apart from selling it online.

Rosley said several agencies including the State Agriculture Department, Farmers Organisation and Mardis have visited his Kelulut farm, which he operates with assistance of his wife and children.

Each of his 100ml Kelulut honey is sold at RM30.

Pricey Musang King cendol a boon for Melaka stall owner

MELAKA: RM38 for a bowl of cendol heaped with dollops of Musang King durian.

Peeved at the price, a customer uploaded a photo of the receipt showing RM114 for three bowls of cendol on his/her Facebook account.

The photo went viral and many agreed that the cendol was overpriced. But it ended up with the cendol seller concerned laughing all the way to the bank.

Muhammad Ariff Qayyum Mohd Zamri, the owner of a stall named Raja Cendol Taming Sari in Bandar Hilir here, said his sales had tripled after the receipt went viral in February.

"I'm so thankful the matter went viral. More people know about my stall and I've more customers now. My workers and I have never been busier," the 25-year-old entrepreneur told Bernama, adding that durian lovers would not mind paying RM38 for a bowl of Musang King cendol as they were well aware of the premium grade durian.

Even before the viral incident, his stall, set up two years ago, was popular due to the variety of durian cendol that he offered.

While the Musang King cendol is the clear winner among his customers, the Udag Merah cendol (RM20 a bowl), D24 cendol (RM20), hybrid durian cendol

(RM17) and normal cendol (RM7) are also popular.

Ariff said he needed about 20kg of durian pulp a day to meet the demand for durian cendol.

"For each serving of Musang King cendol, I use between 120g and 150g of durian flesh."

His durians are mostly sourced from Johor and Pahang.

Since he is particular about the quality of the durians he uses, he has to cope with the fluctuating prices of durians.

"Between November and January, durian prices shoot up due to the smaller harvest. During the durian season from May to August, prices start to drop."

His stall, located near Menara Taming Sari in Bandar Hilir, also serves durian-based dessert called mochi (a Japanese dessert), ice-cream, dodol, candy and mooncake.

Ariff started the business as a part-time two years ago.

Little did he expect his cendol stall would eventually generate an average income of RM90,000 a month.

His income would swell up to RM150,000 a month during the school holidays when visitors throng Melaka.

Prior to setting up the stall, he worked at his family-owned factory at the Melaka Halal Hub in Serkam that produced durian-

based snacks.

"I was earning about RM2,000 a month. Since durian is a seasonal fruit, I used to have a lot of free time and that's when I came up

with the idea of setting up a cendol stall. My uncle and aunt had a delicious cendol recipe."

Using his savings of RM25,000 as capital, he started the venture

with his father Mohd Zamri Mohd Taib, 51, as his adviser. His father had suggested to introduce Musang King cendol and add gula melaka syrup to enhance its taste.

Last year, Ariff raked in RM950,000 in sales and plans to earn RM1.2 million this year. He plans to open branches in Kuala Lumpur and Johor.

Motivated by his success, he has been encouraging youths to venture into the business.

"They must be willing to take risks. The government is providing funds to youths who wish to become entrepreneurs. Grab the opportunity as this field promises good returns."

Ahmad Dhani Mikail, 18, a student from Indonesia, said he fell in love with Musang King cendol after trying it out for the first time.

"I prefer ice kacang to cendol, which in Indonesia has slices of jackfruit added to it. But this cendol durian is delicious," he said.

His friend, Samantha Ng, 18, said she had tasted cendol back home in Singapore but found Raja Cendol Taming Sari's durian cendol the best ever.

"The cendol here is more fragrant and the gula melaka is not that sweet. I can have two bowls of this cendol at one go," she said.

Abdul Manaf Ibrahim, 47, from Seremban, said he was a durian lover and would not miss the chance to enjoy the Musang King cendol whenever he visits Melaka. **Bernama**

PENANG SOUTH RECLAMATION PROJECT

'FISHING FOLK WILL BE WELL TAKEN CARE OF'

They have ample opportunities for jobs, better quality of life, says CM

THE Penang government has given an assurance that the wellbeing of fishermen living in the southern part of the island will not be neglected when the Penang South Reclamation (PSR) mega project is implemented.

This came a day after the march to Parliament by hundreds of fishermen from Penang and Perak, as well as representatives of non-governmental organisations, who opposed the project.

Chief Minister Chow Kon Yeow

said yesterday the fishermen could still go to sea after PSR's implementation.

"At the same time, they and their families will be given ample opportunities for employment and a better quality of life once the project kicks off.

"We, the state government, want to reiterate our stand that the fishing folk will be well taken care of," he said.

Last week, the state government confirmed that it had received the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) approval for PSR, which came with 72 conditions from the Department of Environment (DoE).

The reclamation project, which covers 1,900ha of the sea in the southern part of Penang, would be used to fund the state's ambitious RM46 billion Penang Transport Master Plan (PTMP).

The local fishermen had been opposing the reclamation project since 2015.

Environmentalists had argued that such a project would adversely impact the livelihood of fishermen and the marine ecosystem in the southern part of the island.

On Thursday, Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said action would be taken if it was true that PSR had negative impact on the public and environment.

Chow said during a closed-door meeting on May 31, representatives of the Penang Fishermen Association, led by its chairman Nazri Ahmad, had submitted a proposal for ex-gratia in the event the PSR project kicks off.

"For boat owners, they are asking that each of them be given a special boat, which allows them to fish further while the reclamation work is in progress.

"They are also requesting for low-cost housing to purchase or own through the rent-and-own scheme.

"They also asked for a temporary jetty to be built," he said.

As for the fishing crew, Chow said, each of them had requested for low-cost housing through a rent-and-own scheme.

"The state government will study their requests and look into our compensation package for fishermen who are affected by other reclamation projects.

"But we also want to point out that none of the fishermen's villages will be demolished as this involved only coastal reclamation, and they can continue to stay in their existing homes.

"The state executive councillor has requested for the task force set up to look into the fishermen's concerns to begin formal talks

with them," he said, adding that the first meeting had been planned for September.

Chow said the state government was prepared to brief the prime minister or any other parties on PSR if the need arose.

Previously, the National Physical Planning Council had outlined 18 recommendations before the project could be given the go-ahead.

Agriculture and Agro-based Industries Minister Datuk Salahuddin Ayub had said the federal government had yet to make an official decision on PSR, noting that they were waiting for reports from several parties on the implementation of the mega-reclamation project.

研发更多副产品 燕窝商勿依赖出口

大马燕窝生产量居全球第二，每年燕窝产量约400公吨。惟，谈及养燕、毛燕出口中国等课题，仍充斥挑战及争议，有待厂商及政府携手解决。本期《东方上电台》请来大马燕窝产业出口商协会会长拿督蔡千根，剖析我国燕窝业现状及前景。

目前我国未获准出口毛燕，即未经过消毒、清理的燕窝原料至中国，但国内已不少燕窝商家和燕农反映，希望中国解除进口毛燕的准证。对此，蔡千根斩钉截铁说，出口毛燕对我国燕窝产业而言弊大于利。

蔡千根分析，许多燕农或加工厂不了解产业生态，只看见出口毛燕即能赚钱的暴利。若中国真开放进口，只有少数大型厂商会购买。而开放时他们会大量进口，我国燕农及毛燕出口商尝到甜头后，渐发依赖这门生意。一旦中国政策调整足够强而不再进口，出口商及燕农便再无利可图。

更何況，大家都将出口毛燕至中国时，必然导致我国燕窝加工产业萎缩。中国真有一天停止购买我国毛燕后，余下的加工厂无法再消化囤积国内的货品。

蔡千根认为，与其依赖出口毛燕，倒不如大力开发加工品，将燕窝制成更附加价值产品。目前国内加工厂大



我国燕窝口碑佳，大受国外认可，源于厂商遵循政府规定，从燕窝采集到加工流程都严谨把关。

多仅执行梳毛和清理流程，或制成即食燕窝。技术含量不高，应思考利用燕窝制造保健品、药品、护肤品等。

没被剥削情况

他补充，国民大学（UKM）、博特拉大学（UPM）等高等学府研究团队已发现，燕窝能修复脑细胞增强记忆力、改善胰岛素等，功能和商机不限于现时常见的即食品。

他同时感叹，上述研发已在中国蓬勃发展，我国却碍于长年争论是否要出口毛燕，荒废不少研发时间。若再辩论，往后反倒要面对国外出口的保健

品，「明明我们自己都能做」。

他补充，研发新产品后亦可开拓欧美市场，减少对中国的依赖。欧美人对吃燕窝有「吃燕窝」的刻板印象，甚少进口即食燕窝。我国燕窝厂商研发保健品后，他们反而能接受。这是未被发掘的商机。

他澄清，本身是从国家及整体产业利益出发，反对出口毛燕，不存在外界所称「加工厂剥削燕农」的状况。

许多人扬言我们不鼓励出口毛燕至中国，是想逼各加工厂继续向燕窝加价。这说法不正确，因我国燕农向来自由买卖及根据市场价格定价，不存在被剥削或压迫的情况。

监管工作不马虎 奠定我国燕窝名声

我国燕窝品质大受国外认可，口碑极佳，大马燕窝产业出口商协会会长拿督蔡千根认为，这是因法规严谨使然。

产品好不好并非以产量或产地定义，而是管理方式。如何打理燕巢、注重卫生，都是能否产出优质燕窝的关键因素。

蔡千根解释，我国农业及农垦工业部、卫生部早已制定明确规范于燕窝产业，还会派官员来抽检出口品，监管工作绝不马虎。

这很重要，因我国燕窝最大消费市场是中国。他们十分认真看待进口燕窝品质和管控流程。我们的货品干净，他们才认可我们。

他指出，中国会以病毒、细菌、细菌这3大指标评价进口货品，目的为防堵疫情。他们人口太多，爆发疫情后会加速蔓延全国。例如猪瘟，区区3个月时间就已从北方传到南方，所以不得不严格管制进口物品。

我们要打进这庞大市场，就得考量这些因素，提高品质要求。

他也感叹，燕农业者在我国该有的地位仍很模糊，亟待申请外劳或贷款程序，冀农业部及内政部能正视此事。「在各项文件时，我们不被允许自称自己是「燕窝业者」，只能填工业或农业商人。」

一旦填农业，移民局来检查，发现外劳正在挑毛后，会发问这是工业还是农业。填工业时，官员则认为外劳像是进行农业的工作，总之角度不到岸。

他补充，基于本地人不愿从事挑毛、清理等工作，外劳依旧是业者主要人力资源。若政府不正视上述窘境，整体产业会逐步萎缩。「该查问题后，这产业才受法律保护，有助吸引更多投资。」

只是噱头 血燕非燕子吐血

一些燕窝业者将较贵的血燕，认为其营养价值高于较常见的白燕。大马燕窝产业出口商协会会长拿督蔡千根解释，所谓「燕子必吐血而吐出的血珠」，只是燕窝商家营销消费者的行销手法。

蔡千根指，血燕只是噱头，旨在与白燕区隔，吸引消费者掏更多钱购买。

他透露，血燕可分成自然制成及人工制成。前者即燕窝巢未被采集时，因山

洞气候、潮湿、铁质和矿物质影响，自然由白色氧化成红色。

至于人工制成，他指由燕巢主将大量鸟粪搬进燕巢，作由粪便产生的氨气结合潮湿度染红燕窝。「有业者原仅打算利用黄巢美味吸引更多燕子，飞进其燕巢筑巢，就料却一并染红燕窝。」

此前血燕制造者大多为印尼居民。2011年爆发白燕风波后，现已不多人做，但国人还是得小心，别被商家的广告欺骗。

他补充，华人普遍有「白色食品比较补」的迷思，更替成为不少商家欺骗目标。

槟填海特工队 9月与渔民商赔偿

曹观友是于周五在光大酒楼召开记者会时表示，州政府是在5月31日接获渔民代表的诉求，当时是由其政治秘书郑崇兴出面与渔民代表进行初步会议，以商讨关于渔业资源等。曹称，希望渔民及渔民的诉求能得到妥善处理。

他表示，渔民代表在会议中向州政府要求先进渔船，以及渔民和船员可获得优先权购买房屋，或获得先租后买的廉价房屋，当中并没有提及任何关于金钱上的补偿。

他说，为了渔民的需求及安全，渔民也提出希望州政府能为他们兴建耐用的码头，以让他们

们可拥有地方继续出海作业。

另外，曹观友也指已知悉渔民代表及市政府组织早前曾到国会抗议一事，而槟州南部填海计划的环境评估报告已通过了，因此，州政府会按照程序与渔民代表商讨补偿事宜。

不会剥削渔民福利

他也强调，非政府不会剥削渔民的福利，该计划并不会影响该地区的繁荣，所有工程都是在海上进行。

曹观友也承认非政府将带来大马渔业发展的挑战，对渔民的诉求作出研究，槟州南部填海特工队也会与渔民作进一步的商讨。

另一方面，针对首相敦马哈迪同意检讨槟州南部填海获批的事情，曹观友则回应，任何单位都想了解更多有关计划的详情，非政府都会邀请代表向他们解释并澄清。

他也表示，槟州南部填海计划已由国家实体规划理事会决定当时所划定的18块条件中，有其中一块清楚列明，非政府需

考量该计划对渔民的影响，而目前州政府也已按照程序与渔民商讨补偿方案。

另外，槟州行政议员阿菲夫则指已在5月31日与槟州渔民协会代表会面，州政府将对渔民提出的补偿方案作出研究，并在今年9月再次召开会议。

他指出特工队已成立，并由槟州副部长莫哈末塞迪基、农业部副部长达志睦、槟州行政议员拿督阿都哈林、塞义丹和议员阿斯鲁，槟州交通大臣谢特穆拉目被理拿督林祥成组成。

曹觀友：接獲訴求

9月與檳南部漁民談判

（檳城12日訊）檳首长曹觀友说，州政府已接获南部渔民的诉求，包括要求先进渔船及优先购买廉价屋，以檳州卫生、农业及农基工业及乡区发展委员会主席阿菲夫为首的檳島南部填海特工作队，将于9月与渔民协会代表展开谈判。

他透露，他与其政治秘书郑来兴及阿菲夫，5月31日曾与檳島南部渔民代表展开闭门会议，当时渔民代表有提呈诉求建议书，渔民除了要求先进渔船及优先购买或先租后售廉价屋，也提及船员要求优先购买或先租后售廉价屋。

“渔民代表也要求在进行填海工程时，必须要兴建一个安全的临时码头。”

填海工程没拆屋

曹觀友今年召开记者会说，州政府将研究有关建议，并会听取其他政府机构如渔业发展局的意见，也会参考以前进行工程时渔民所获的赔偿后，再做考虑。

不过，曹觀友也强调，既然渔民没有要求现金，而是要求赔偿先进渔船，也就代表渔民还是可以继续捕鱼，只是需要去到比较远的地方。

“而且填海工程并没有涉及到拆屋，只是在海上的工程，但有人趁机要求购买或先租后售廉价屋。”

阿菲夫说，此特工作队在建设填海工程时就已经成立，当时由时任州行政议员拿督阿都马烈为首，也有提议在获得环评报告后，再继续与渔民代表讨论。

“如今获得环评报告后，我们会指示展开谈判，但需要时间研究现有的建议，因此预计9月谈判。”

他说，此特工作队包括旅游、艺术及文化副部长兼浮罗山背国会议员莫哈末峇迪亚，及农业及农基工业部副部长兼峇株巴辖国会议员沈志勤等。

州政府願講解南部填海計劃

针对日前有渔民与非政府组织人士到国会外和平集会，要求政府正视渔民和环境问题，取消檳島南部填海计划，而首相敦马哈迪指希盟政府会研究要求取消有关计划一事，曹觀友说，若有需要，州政府愿意为任何一方进行讲解会。

他透露，早前在国家实体规划理事会上发表及讨论这项计划时，其中一个被劝告要进行的，就是解决渔民所受的影响，包括考虑赔偿。
