KOTA BHARU: Kementerian Pertanian dan Industri Asas Tani (MOA) mahu isu National Feedlot Corporation (NFC) dapat diselesaikan dengan segera kerana ia melibatkan kepentingan awam.

Menterinya, Datuk Salahuddin Ayub berkata, dalam masa terdekat iaitu beberapa bulan lagi sudah ada sebuah syarikat yang berminat untuk membeli NFC.

"Saya telah membuat kenyataan seawal berada di MOA, sebuah syarikat berminat untuk beli NFC, kita telah lihat syarat-syarat itu dan perkara ini telah diajukan kepada perdana menteri dan menteri kewangan," katanya. Beliau berkata demikian kepada media ketika ditemui pada

majlis berbuka puasa bersama warga MOA Kelantan, di Kota Bharu, pada Selasa.

Katanya, pihaknya menyambut baik sekiranya syarikat berkenaan dapat memenuhi syarat-syarat yang ditetapkan termasuk menyelesaikan pinjaman dengan Kementerian Kewangan.

"Menteri kewangan dah beri respon bahawa NFC perlu kembalikan semula pinjaman, itu terma yang perlu dipatuhi.

"Saya dimaklumkan syarikat ini memang amat berminat untuk ambil alih NFC dan sekiranya semua syarat dipenuhi, kita tak ada masalah. Syarikat baru boleh meneruskan projek NFC, mungkin kita tukar nama baru," katanya.

Projek NFC perlu diteruskan demi kepentingan negara

KOMITMEN Pengerusi National Feedlot Corporation (NFC), Datuk Seri Dr. Mohamad Salleh Ismail mengenai pembayaran pinjaman lebih RM250 juta kepada kerajaan semalam, menjadi titik tolak penting untuk meneruskan semula projek ternakan lembu serta penghasilan daging yang telah dirancang di bawah NFC.

Beliau sendiri mahukan projek penuh potensi itu dibangunkan semula oleh kerajaan dan pembelian baharu NFC dalam usaha memastikan bekalan daging di pasaran tempatan terjamin.

Meskipun isu NFC penuh dengan kontroversi membabit-

kan beberapa nama besar dalam politik tanah air, namun sewajarnya kisah lama dibiarkan berlalu dan buku baharu dibuka demi kepentingan negara.

Menteri Pertanian dan Industri Asas Tani, Datuk Sallehuddin Ayub juga mahu agar projek itu diberi nafas serta jenama baharu dan dilaksanakan secepat mungkin.

Projek ternakan lembu serta penghasilan daging amat kriti-

kal kepada Malaysia untuk menampung permintaan domestik, membekalkan daging halal selain mengekang import yang boleh mempengaruhi harga daging di pasaran runcit tempatan.

Projek itu juga boleh menggalakkan perkembangan industri serta melahirkan pengusaha tempatan, dan secara tidak langsung memecahkan 'kartel' sekumpulan pihak yang pernah didakwa menguasai sek-

tor pengimportan daging bernilai sekitar RM2 bilion setahun.

Berdasarkan rancangan NFC yang dilancarkan sejak 12 tahun lalu, projek tersebut berhasrat mengeluarkan lebih 8,000 ternakan lembu terutamanya di Gemas, Negeri Sembilan untuk sekurang-kurangnya menampung 30 peratus permintaan daging tempatan.

Johor Corporation (JCorp) pernah dikatakan berminat untuk menguruskan ladang ternakan itu selain dilaporkan beberapa syarikat milik kerajaan (GLC) berkaitan bidang pertanian dan perladangan dialu-alukan bagi


menjayakan projek tersebut.

Penyertaan Felda, Felcra serta Tabung Haji dalam projek ternakan sebegini amat tepat sekali demi membolehkan GLC tersebut mempelbagaikan aktiviti ekonomi selain menyelesaikan kemelut yang sedang dihadapi kesan kejatuhan harga komoditi dan masalah tadbir urus.

Idea menjenamakan semula projek itu tanpa menggunakan nama NFC juga disambut baik untuk membawa semangat baharu selain menghentikan polemik berterusan dalam kalangan ahli-ahli politik yang hanya merugikan rakyat.

KOTA BHARU: The agriculture and agro-based industry ministry has called for a speedy resolution to the National Feedlot Corporation (NFCorp) issue as it involves public interest.

Its minister Salahuddin Ayub said a company had expressed interest in acquiring NFCorp in the near future.

"I have already made a statement that a company is interested in acquiring NFCorp. We have seen the terms, and the matter has been submitted to the prime minister and finance minister," he told reporters at a breaking of fast event

here yesterday.

He said his ministry welcomed the move if the company could meet the conditions, including settling its outstanding loan with the finance ministry.

"The finance minister has said that NFCorp needs to make full repayment of the loan. He has also stated the terms that must be complied with.

"I was informed that the company is very keen to take over NFCorp. If all conditions are met, there should be no problem. The new company can continue the NFCorp project, (but) perhaps we can change the name," he said.

NFC may be rebranded after takeover, says minister



The controversial National Feedlot Corporation Sdn Bhd may be rebranded after its takeover over by a new investor, Agriculture and Agro-based Industries Minister Salahuddin Ayub said today.

Salahuddin said his ministry would welcome the move, so long as the investor fulfils all necessary conditions, including repaying NFC's loan to the Finance Ministry.

He added that he wants the NFC issue resolved as soon as possible because public interest is at stake.

"I have said since I've been with the Agriculture and Agro-based Industries Ministry that a company is interested in buying NFC, and that we have studied the conditions and forwarded it to the prime minister and finance minister.

"The finance minister said NFC must repay the loan. That is the condition that needs to be met," he told reporters during a breaking fast session with Kelantan Agriculture Ministry staff in Kota Bharu.

"I have been informed by the company that it is very keen on taking over NFC, and if all conditions are met, we have no issues.

"The new company can continue the NFC project, and perhaps we can change to a new name," he added.

Yesterday, NFC chairperson Mohamad Salleh Ismail said the potential buyer is prepared to fully repay of the outstanding loan amount within three months of the government greenlighting the takeover.

Salleh was responding to Finance Minister Lim Guan Eng saying that his ministry is seeking full repayment of RM253.6 million in outstanding loan, interest and late payment charges.

Meanwhile, Salahuddin said he would be happy if the NFC project were to continue, because of its objective to supply 30 percent of the local demand for beef.

"I hope this can be resolved quickly. If all conditions are met, the Agriculture Ministry will immediately facilitate the NFC takeover," he said.

Local fragrant rice for KADA, MADA padi areas to be planted on large-scale basis, says minister

PASIR PUTEH, May 21 — The Ministry of Agriculture and Agro-Based Industry will ask the Kemubu Agricultural Development Authority (KADA) and the Muda Agriculture Development Authority (MADA) to begin planting high-quality local fragrant padi soon.

Its minister, Datuk Salahuddin Ayub said the MRQ76 variety which had been planted on a trial basis in Kampung Bendang Kolam, Tembusu, Selising here had proven to be on par with rice from Thailand and Vietnam.

"The trial cultivation turned out successful and studies showed that the rice was of high quality and on par with imported rice.

"I will propose that KADA and MADA plant this rice on a large scale basis so that it can be produced locally," he told reporters after a dialogue session and launch of the padi harvest here today.

Also present were KADA chairman, Senator Datuk Husam Musa and chairman of the Kelantan Fragrant Rice Operators' Association Zailan Awang.

Salahuddin said to encourage farmers to plant the fragrant rice, his ministry would provide the same subsidy as that given to other padi planters.

"Farmers who grow this fragrant rice will enjoy the same subsidy, and this is the first time we are introducing this because before, fragrant padi growers did not get it," he said.

Salahuddin said the price of this fragrant rice could increase the farmers' incomes as every five kilogrammes could fetch RM40 compared to RM15 for ordinary padi.

（新山 21 日讯）农业及农基工业部长拿督沙拉胡丁指出，大马黄梨出口在 2018 年取得 56% 的增长，出口额达 3 亿 4200 万令吉。

他说，同比进口 1 亿 5900 万令吉的黄梨制成品，我国黄梨业在去年取得 1 亿 8300 万令吉的贸易顺差。

列新收入来源

沙拉胡丁昨日到武吉英达花园一家黄梨饼制作厂参观后

向记者说，政府已把黄梨列为新收入来源，而且该部接下来将鼓励垦殖民在栽种油棕及橡胶之外，也同时兼种黄梨，可助增加农民收入。

“政府目标是希望从 2017 年的 2032 公顷，到了 2020 年可扩大至 5500 公顷，尤其是 MD2 和 N36 品种的黄梨。”

他说，我国的黄梨产品外销超过 20 个国家及地区，包括日本、韩国、中国、香港、新加坡、阿拉伯联合酋长国、沙地阿拉伯、伊朗、埃及、德国及法国。

他说，国内对黄梨产品的需求也有上升，主要是 MD2 品种黄梨，尤其是它没有季节性，而且价格公道。

鉴定特定 FELDA 地区

他说，当局正鉴定特定 FELDA 地区：“我认为在年底前，我们应该可在数个被遴选的 FELDA 地区，进行数个试点项目。”

沙拉胡丁提及，黄梨成为混栽植物的潜能，符合市场想要提升黄梨，尤其是 MD2 品种黄梨的种植范围。

GROOMING AGROPRENEURS

UiTM PERAK'S PINEAPPLE VENTURE

FOLLOWING discussions with UiTM Perak branch in February, the head of department of the Perak branch of the Malaysian Pineapple Industry Board (MPIB) and her team visited the university's Seri Iskandar campus.

It was to determine whether the site was suitable for planting MD2 pineapples. The MPIB team was welcomed by UiTM Perak Deputy Rector (Academic) Associate Professor Dr Norhayati Baharun.

Upon deciding that the site was suitable to plant the crop, MPIB allocated RM17,000 — worth 10,000 MD2 seedlings — to UiTM Perak.

In March, the first phase of the

project started with students planting 200 MD2 pineapple seedlings, supplied by the state MPIB.

The Department of Agriculture has said pineapple is a major crop apart from papaya, banana, mango, pomelo, watermelon and jackfruit. MD2 has been identified as a suitable fruit crop that can be exported, as well as ensures food security.

Since the demand for MD2 pineapples is high locally and abroad, UiTM Perak decided to venture into planting it.

MD2 pineapples have three grades: A, B and C. The grades are determined by the weight of the fruit, which is between 1.5kg and 2.5kg.

Grade A MD2 pineapples are reserved for the international markets.

MPIB believes that for Malaysia to have a larger share of the world production of pineapples, it needs to produce about 700,000 tonnes this year.

This means that Malaysia

needs to groom more industrial planters.

UiTM Perak Rector Associate Professor Dr Md Yusof Hamid and the executive management were supportive of the project.

By sharing agricultural knowledge, especially in planting MD2 pineapples, the university can

create more agropreneurs among its graduates. It is hoped that these graduates will add value to the development of agriculture practices.

'Lapor polis jika terima ugutan'

KEMENTERIAN Pertanian dan Industri Asas Tani (MoA) menasihatkan nelayan di Muar yang mendakwa menerima ugutan pihak berkuasa laut untuk membuat laporan polis.

Menterinya, Datuk Salahuddin Ayub berkata, laporan polis tersebut bagi membolehkan beliau dan kementerian mengambil tindakan susulan.

"Sebagai menteri, saya tak boleh bertindak atas *hear say*. Mesti ada laporan lengkap. Tetapi perkara ini telah dibangkitkan YB Syed Saddiq sebagai Ahli Parlimen Muar.

"Saya mengambil maklum dan perkara itu telah pun sampai ke peringkat jawatankuasa khas Kabinet untuk kita bertindak," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika diminta mengulas mengenai dakwaan nelayan di Muar yang diugut dan sengaja ditahan pihak berkuasa laut setelah mengemukakan bukti mengenai pencerobohan bot pukut tunda haram.

Salahuddin yang juga Ahli Parlimen Pula berkata, beliau perlu terlebih dahulu melihat perincian dakwaan tersebut dan laporan polis sekiranya dibuat nelayan terbabit.

Selain itu, ditanya MoA sudah membuat keputusan sama ada membenarkan tanaman guarana, beliau berkata, guarana masih dalam kajian.

"Walaupun saya tidak boleh menafikan potensi dari segi harga, tetapi setiap varieti tanaman yang masuk ke negara ini memerlukan laporan daripada kuarantin.

Reasons for 'surge' in Viet fishermen encroachment

KUALA LUMPUR: Vietnamese trawlers encroach on Malaysian waters partly because it is less stringently policed compared with the sea around the Paracels and Spratlys archipelago, where Chinese forces have a strong presence.

Vietnamese fishermen are also venturing further out into the open sea after over-harvesting, dredging and the building of artificial islands had damaged 160 sq km of their country's seabed.

A fisheries industry expert said poaching had also resulted in the depletion of Vietnam's fish stock by as much as 70 per cent over the past 20 years.

Fisheries Department Director-General Datuk Munir Mohd Nawi told the *NST*, these had caused the Vietnamese fishermen to trespass on Malaysian waters to plunder some RM6 billion in marine resources a year.

The worst part was that the illegal fishermen used dragnets that destroy the priceless marine ecosystem including corals.

Vietnam's fishing industry employs more than 4.5 million people and is the world's fourth largest exporter of fish after China, Norway and Thailand.

The Vietnamese Association of Seafood Exporters and Producers (Vasep) reported that the country's catch amounted to US\$10 billion (RM41 billion) a year.

Former Maritime Institute of Malaysia (Mima) director-general retired First Admiral Datuk Chin Yoon Chin said there were more than 80,000 trawlers operated by Vietnamese fishermen.

"Their favourite catch are the expensive bluefin tuna and equally high-priced yellowfin tuna. Other popular ones are

grouper, squid, cockles and shell-fish, crabs, shrimps, snapper, lobsters, oysters and baby sharks."

A Bluefin tuna reportedly sells for US\$200 per kg, while yellowfin tuna can fetch US\$8 per kg. Earlier this year, a 277.6kg bluefin tuna was sold for US\$3 million in Japan.

"The extraction of this natural resource in the South China Sea has been the cause of many international spats recently.

"The area is biologically diverse and home to 3,365 species of fish. It is also one of the five most productive fishing zones in the world with regard to total annual marine production.

"It helps the coastal economy and is crucial for the export trade and food security of 12 countries and territories it borders."

Chin added that since 1998, Vietnam had offered US\$65 million in economic incentives and preferential loans to its offshore fishermen to upgrade their vessels with powerful engines and modern equipment.

"Private businesses and foreign-invested businesses linked to Vasep are also given tax reductions during the first three years of offshore fisheries business," said Chin.

He said there were 31 ports from where the Vietnamese trawlers operated.

However, only seven could accommodate large vessels equipped with 400hp engines — Lach Bang and Lach Hoi in Thanh Hoa province; Cua Hoi in Nghe An province; Xuan Pho in Ha Tinh province; Song Gianh in Quang Binh province; Con Co in Quang Tri province; and Thuan Phuoc in Da Nang province.

Outbreak caused by smuggled cattle

TUMPAT: The cattle smuggling across the Malaysia-Thailand border in Kelantan has been identified as the cause of the outbreak of foot and mouth disease among cattle in Malaysia.

Veterinary Services Department director-general Datuk Quaza Nizamuddin Hassan Nizam said this was because cows brought into the country illegally had not undergone the necessary quarantine process and vaccinations.

"As of April this year, there were 10 cases of foot and mouth disease involving cattle nationwide. This is a big number as there were only 35 cases reported last year.

"Most of the cases occurred in Pahang, Johor and Melaka. We

found that these cases mostly involved cattle from Kelantan, which were brought into the country illegally from Thailand," he said.

He was speaking to reporters after officiating the Tumpat district livestock breeders conference, which was attended by the Agriculture and Agro-based Industries minister's special func-

tions officer Wan Johari Wan Omar and Kelantan Veterinary Services Department director Suratan Kamarudin.

The *New Straits Times* on Monday reported that the General Operations Force (GOF) seized more than 300 cows, goats and sheep worth almost RM1 million which were smuggled into Kelantan via Sungai Golok over the weekend.

GOF believed that the number of smuggled livestock was expected to increase in the coming days due to the demand for meat ahead of Hari Raya.

Smugglers, said the agency, took the opportunity of high demand from locals to smuggle the livestock.

GOF officers also found that most of the smuggled cattle had

fake ear tags to make them appear to be legally certified.

Quaza said Malaysia currently supplied only 23 per cent of its own meat to the local market.

"Livestock production has been static in recent years. We hope that more Malaysians will get involved in this industry as there is large demand here for livestock," he said. **Bernama**

Kelantan farmers encouraged to take up coffee planting

TUMPAT: The Kemubu Agricultural Development Authority (KADA) encourages farmers in Kelantan to grow coffee in an effort to develop the industry following worldwide demand for the beverage.

KADA chairman, Senator Datuk Husam Musa said, for this purpose it plans to discuss with the Malaysian Agricultural Research and Development Institute (MARDI) to provide seedlings free to farmers for a start so as to get them involved in the coffee industry.

"KADA together with the Kelantan Coffee Club can make a success of this endeavour, while MARDI can provide seeds and seedlings to be distributed to the farmers.

"When the coffee is produced, it can be

supplied to the manufacturer to produce their own local coffee brands that can be developed for local and international markets," he said at the Colek dinner event and Lojing Coffe Launch at Wakaf Bharu, here, Monday night.

Also present were KADA deputy manager (development) Nik Roslan Idris and owner of Lojing Coffee, Wan Izzuddin Wan Sulaiman.

"We expect Kelantan to produce up to RM10 million to RM50 million worth of coffee per year. The amount will contribute to the people's income and create a value chain in the coffee industry," he said.

He said, at the moment they had no specific plans, and intend to discuss with the relevant parties including the Forest

Research Institute Malaysia (FRIM) and MARDI after Hari Raya Aidilfitri for the supply of seedlings.

According to Husam, coffee cultivation was already underway on a small scale in the villages, but the effort was not being commercialised for various reasons.

"Already having a sophisticated coffee outlet and successful coffee producers, including two under KADA, we can develop the industry. I only plan to give coffee seedlings to farmers who already have land for planting," he said.

He added that if farmers were keen on developing the effort, discussions can be held separately whether to grow coffee as a main or secondary crop. —Bernama

他说，任何有兴趣的商家可与当局提出建议，讨论

到底要以小规模方式栽种，或者是商业化的大规模方式。

Peniaga beras, Mohd Norazim Abd Razak, 33, berkata beliau tidak terluar memikirkan keuntungan, sebaliknya mahu rezeki diterimanya mendapat keberkatan.

Katanya, niat membantu golongan kurang berkemampuan sudah ditetapkan apabila syarikatnya mendapat lesen daripada Kawal Selia Padi Dan Beras Kedah dan Bekalan dari Padi Beras Nasional Berhad (BERNAS), Septembar tahun lalu.

"Dengan bantuan pemasaran daripada Lembaga Pemasaran Pertanian Persekutuan (FAMA), saya membuka kedai di Jalan Kolej Heights Utara Darul Aman supaya

pembeli boleh terus membeli beras di situ.

"Sasaran pelanggan adalah masyarakat luar bandar yang bekerja kampung seperti pesawah dan penoreh getah, jadi harga jualan beras 10 kilogram (kg) hanya RM22 berbanding harga pasaran RM26.

Tak fikir keuntungan

"Walaupun keuntungan rendah, saya puas apabila melihat golongan kurang berkemampuan datang membeli dan dengan cara ini saya dapat berkongsi rezeki bersama mereka," katanya.

Mohd Norazim berkata, pada peringkat awal perniagaan, beliau hanya mampu menjual kira-kira lima tan beras sebulan, namun selepas tiga bulan, jualaninya mencecah antara 20 hingga 30 tan sebulan.

"Saya berniaga bukan untuk memberi saingan kepada peniaga

lain, saya ada golongan sasar sendiri dan kerana itu saya bermiaga di kawasan luar bandar saja.

"Selain Jitra, saya juga membuka kedai di Kuala Nerang dan tahun ini, saya merancang membuka enam lagi kedai di luar bandar dengan peruncit juga boleh mendapatkan bekalan beras terus daripada saya," katanya.

Ditanya mengenai jualan beras ketika Ramadan, Mohd Norazim mengakui ia agak perlahan pada minggu pertama, namun kembali meningkat apabila orang perseorangan dan syarikat swasta membeli beras bagi tujuan membayar zakat fitrah serta diijadikan sumbangan.

Beliau berharap lebih ramai peniaga dapat melakukan perkara sama iaitu membantu golongan miskin dan pada masa sama mengesjar generasi akhirat.

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Nelayan sambut baik janji syarikat

SAMA seperti sajian orang Perak yang tidak lengkap tanpa tempoyak atau cencalok bagi orang Melaka, begitu juga halnya sambal hitam di Pahang. Usaha mengkomersialkan makanan warisan itu membuatnya semakin dikenali terutama dalam kalangan mereka yang mengemari makanan autentik. Perkembangan itu turut mengujakan seorang pengusaha sambal hitam, Siti Aminah Shamsuddin, 39, yang berbangga apabila makanan asli negerinya kini popular. Jika dahulu sekadar 'makanan orang kampung', kini sambal hitam sudah ada di restoran-restoran besar, bahkan turut 'masuk' ke istana. "Tiga tahun lalu ketika saya menyuarkan hasrat untuk berniaga sambal hitam, ahli

keluarga saya agak skeptikal, tidak yakin ada orang mahu beli makanan kampung itu. "Idea itu timbul selepas saya berhenti kerja sebagai pengurus sumber manusia dan tercari-cari apa yang boleh dilakukan bagi menjana pendapatan. "Saya terfikir untuk buat sambal hitam kerana sejak kecil itulah yang emak hidangkan. "Percayalah, dalam bulan Ramadan, sekadar nasi panas, telur dadar, ulam dan sambal hitam sudah cukup membuka selera terutama ketika sahur," katanya kepada Mega Rona. Menurutny, terdapat tiga variasi sambal hitam iaitu Sambal Hitam Ikan Talang, Sambal Hitam Ikan Bilis Basah dan Sambal Hitam Ikan Bilis

Kering di bawah jenama Minz, iaitu gabungan namanya dan suami, Zahari Jaffar, 56. Wanita berasal dari Raub, Pahang itu menjadi pengusaha pertama memperkenalkan Sambal Hitam Ikan Talang hasil inovasi menggunakan ikan talang jeruk.

Ditanya keistimewaan produk itu, Siti Aminah berkata, dia berusaha mengekalkan rasa asli sambal hitam tanpa menggunakan perisa tambahan.

"Sambal hitam yang asli ada rasa aroma asap kerana orang dahulu masak menggunakan dapur kayu. Sambal akan dimasak lama sehingga 12 jam untuk memastikan belimbing buluh benar-benar kecut dan airnya kering. Sebab itu bau asap dari kayu api menyatu dalam sambal membuatkan rasanya unik.

"Rasa itu juga yang saya cuba kekalkan. Sebab itu, belimbing buluh yang saya gunakan dimasak oleh saudara-mara di kampung di Ulu Tembeling menggunakan dapur kayu.

"Selepas itu, barulah saya masak dengan bahan lain.

"Saya memang tidak berkompromi dari segi rasa kerana saya mahu pelanggan menikmati rasa sebenar sambal hitam sebagaimana yang saya biasa makan semasa zaman kanak-kanak dahulu.

"Alhamdulillah, pelanggan yang sudah biasa makan sambal hitam mengakui keaslian rasa sambal hitam saya," katanya sambil memberitahu kedainya terletak di Setia Alam, Selangor.

Ditanya mengenai cabaran, katanya, paling getir adalah ketika enam bulan pertama beroperasi apabila setiap hari dia terpaksa bangun seawal pukul 4 pagi untuk ke pasar membeli barang, kemudian masak, membungkus, menghantar tempahan dan sebagainya.

"Semua ini dilakukan sendiri tanpa dibantu suami seperti sekarang.

"Jika tidak memasak, saya akan tebakkan muka, pergi dari satu kedai ke satu kedai untuk minta izin meletakkan produk saya. Sudah tak ada rasa malu lagi," katanya.

Melalui bantuan teknologi Institut Kemajuan dan Penyelidikan Pertanian (MARDI), dia berjaya memendekkan tempoh memasak tanpa menjejaskan kualiti produknya.

Kini selepas tiga tahun, Siti Aminah berkata, selain mempunyai lebih 20 ejen atau wakil pengedar, Sambal Hitam Minz turut ditempatkan di kedai vendor sekitar Shah Alam dan Kuala Lumpur dan terbaru boleh didapati di stesen minyak Petronas terpilih.
