Bekalan makanan negara terkawal sepanjang tempoh Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan

SHAH ALAM - Kementerian Pertanian dan Industri Makanan akan memastikan bekalan barangan makanan di negara ini stabil serta terkawal sepanjang tempoh Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan susulan penularan koronavirus (Covid-19).

Menterinya, Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee berkata, pemantauan dilakukan secara berterusan dan akan dimaklumkan kepada orang ramai daripada masa ke masa terhadap sebarang perkembangan.

Menurutnya, stok beras di peringkat kilang, borong dan runcit masih pada tahap konsisten dengan purata 400,000 hingga 500,000 tan metrik sebulan berbanding keperluan bulanan negara sebanyak 200,000 tan metrik.

“Pengeluaran serta bekalan daging dan telur ayam yang kebanyakannya dihasilkan secara tempatan adalah mencukupi untuk menampung permintaan domestik.

“Secara purata, pengeluaran ayam adalah antara 57 sehingga 59 juta ekor sebulan berbanding penggunaan dalam negara antara 43 sehingga 45 juta ekor sebulan.

“Pengeluaran telur sebulan adalah sebanyak 800 juta biji berbanding penggunaan sekitar 620

sehingga 630 juta biji sebulan,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan semalam.

Beliau berkata, bekalan daging lembu dan kerbau sebanyak 18,000 tan metrik termasuk bekalan daging sejuk beku yang diimport dari negara luar seperti Australia dan India dianggarkan mencukupi untuk keperluan semasa.

Menurutnya, pengeluaran bahan keperluan makanan lain terutama ikan bagi suku tahun pertama 2020

tidak mengalami perubahan ketara.

“Pengeluaran sayur-sayuran dan buah-buahan tempatan juga tidak menunjukkan kesan yang ketara, namun begitu jumlah eksport ke negara luar seperti Singapura dan China menunjukkan tren penurunan akibat penularan wabak Covid-19.

“Dalam keadaan ini pihak kementerian akan terus memantau perkara ini bagi memastikan golongan petani, nelayan dan penternak tidak terjejas,” katanya.

Sehubungan itu, beliau berkata, kementerian menasihati orang ramai supaya tidak membuat pembelian panik dan menyimpan bekalan bahan makanan secara berlebihan.

Food supply stable, under control – Kiandee

PUTRAJAYA: Food supply in Malaysia is currently stable and under control, says Agriculture and Food Industry Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee.

He said the ministry would continue to work with the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs as well as other ministries to ensure food supply remained stable during the movement control order period.

He was referring to the order from March 18 to 31, announced by Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin yesterday in an effort to curb the spread of Covid-19.

"The ministry will continue to monitor and inform the public from time to time in the event of any domestic or external developments following the implementation of the movement control order which could affect the existing food supply chain," he said in a statement yesterday.

Kiandee said rice stocks at the mill, wholesale and retail stage were at a consistent level, averaging 400,000 to 500,000 tonnes per month compared to the national monthly requirement of 200,000 tonnes.

"The ministry regularly monitors the supply of rice through the mill,

wholesale and retail licensees," he said.

The minister further said that the production and supply of meat and eggs, which were mostly locally produced was sufficient to meet domestic demand.

"On average, chicken production is 57 million to 59 million a month compared to the domestic consumption of 43 million to 45 million chickens a month," he said.

"Egg production per month is about 800 million compared to consumption at around 620 million to 630 million per month," he noted.

He said although the supply of food such as fish, vegetables and fruits for domestic consumption was sufficient, exports to countries such as Singapore and China showed a decline following the Covid-19 outbreak.

"The ministry will continue to monitor this situation to ensure that our farmers, fishermen and livestock breeders are not adversely affected," he added.

He also stressed that people should avoid making excessive purchases of food items which could lead to situations of imbalance in terms of their access to food supply. - Bernama

Country's food supply stable and regulated, assures minister

PUTRAJAYA: The status of the country's food supply is stable and regulated, says Agriculture and Food Industry Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee.

He said while there is enough rice, meat, eggs, fish, beef, vegetables and fruits in the market, his ministry will continue to monitor developments that could affect the existing food supply chain in light of the nationwide movement control order which takes effect today.

Production and supply of mostly locally produced meat and chicken in Malaysia is sufficient to meet domestic demand. On average, poultry production is between 57 and 59 million chickens a month compared to domestic consumption of between 43 and 45 million per month.

The production of eggs per month is 800 million eggs compared to the consumption recorded at around 620 to 630 million eggs per month,' he said in a statement yesterday.

The minister also said rice stocks at factory, wholesale and retail levels are still at an average level of 400,000-500,000 tonnes per month compared with the national monthly requirement of 200,000 tonnes.

He also said the 10,000 tonnes of beef and buffalo supply, including frozen meat imported from countries such as Australia and India, was estimated to be sufficient for current needs.

As for production of other foodstuff, especially fish, for the first quarter of 2020, there has been no significant change, but added his ministry will continue to monitor the matter to ensure that fishermen and farmers are not affected by the order.

The production of local vegetables and fruits has also not shown a significant impact on supply at the moment. The number of exports to countries such as Singapore and China has shown a declining trend as a result of the Covid-19 outbreak,' he added.

In the meantime, Ronald advised the public not to do panic-buying and stock-piling of groceries, saying it could lead to a situation where there is an imbalance in terms of access to food to the public.

My ministry will continue to work with the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs as well as other ministries to ensure food supply remains stable and regulated throughout the movement control order period,' he said.

KPDNHEP jamin bekalan cukup

Putrajaya: Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Hal Ehwal Pengguna (KPDNHEP) memberi jaminan bekalan makanan, khususnya barangan kawalan mencukupi di pasaran.

Menterinya, Datuk Alexander Nanta Linggi, berkata tiada keperluan orang ramai melakukan pembelian paik atau menyimpan barangan berlebihan kerana keadaan masih terkawal.

Katanya, barangan seperti gula, minyak masak dan tepung gandum mencukupi di pasar raya dan kedai runcit bagi kegunaan domestik.

"Lebih 2,500 penguat kuasa KPDNHEP seluruh negara diarah memantau bekalan supaya peniaga tidak mengambil kesempatan menaikkan harga dan mengadakan aktiviti menyorok barangan.

"KPDNHEP belum mengenakan sekatan kemasukan barangan luar negara seperti dilakukan beberapa negara Asia Barat yang terkesan COVID-19," katanya selepas Majlis Perasmian Cawangan Tealive ke-506 di KPDNHEP di sini, semalam.

Beliau turut memaklumkan kerajaan akan menghentikan eksport penutup hidung dan mulut dalam masa terdekat bagi memberi ketutamaan kepada pengguna tempatan.

Sementara itu, aktiviti pasar malam dan gerai tepi jalan turut diarah tutup, dengan menggalakan pengusaha restoran menjual makanan secara bungkus.

Dalam perkembangan berkaitan, Menteri Pertanian dan Industri Makanan, Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Khandee, berkata bekalan makanan negara ketika ini stabil

dan terkawal.

Beliau berkata, pilihannya sudah mengambil langkah persediaan bagi menjamin bekalan mencukupi ketika Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan dikuat kuasa bermula hari ini hingga 31 Mac.

Beliau berkata, kedudukan stok beras peringkat kilang, borong dan runcit masih berada pada tahap konsisten, iaitu purata 400,000 hingga 500,000 tan setiap bulan, berbanding keperluan bulanan negara iaitu 200,000 tan.

"Kementerian sentiasa memantau kedudukan stok beras secara berkala melalui pemegang lesen kilang, borong dan runcit beras.

"Pengeluaran dan bekalan daging serta telur ayam kebanyakannya dihasilkan secara tempatan, mencukupi untuk menampung permintaan domestik.

"Secara purata, pengeluaran ayam antara 57 sehingga 59 juta ekor sebulan berbanding penggunaan dalam negara dicatatkan antara 43 sehingga 45 juta ekor sebulan. Pengeluaran telur sebulan 800 juta biji berbanding penggunaan pada sekitar 620 sehingga 630 juta biji sebulan," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.
