"In general, the nation's food supply is sufficient and under control, but there is a need to scrutinise and improve food security," he said in a statement here, today.

Kiandee said the committee would seek input and views from various stakeholders including academics, industry players, Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) as well as farmers, breeders and fishermen.

"This is to ensure that the policies formulated are comprehensive and can help the government to handle food security issues effectively," he said.

The committee, to be chaired by Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, comprises Kiandee representing his Ministry, the Minister of Finance, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Economic Affairs), Science, Technology and Innovation Minister, Health Minister, International Trade and Industry Minister, Domestic Trade And Consumer Affairs Minister, Plantation Industries and Commodities Minister, Transport Minister, Rural Development Minister and Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Special Functions).

"The establishment of the Cabinet Committee on the National Food Security Policy is committed in ensuring that the level of food security is always stable in terms of availability, accessibility, safety and affordability to the people at all times," he said.

According to Kiandee, the policy would complement the Agro-Food Policy 2.0 currently being drafted by his ministry, and would be in line with the government's aspirations under the 12th Malaysia Plan, Shared Prosperity Vision and Sustainable Development Goals.

## Seized agricultural goods to feed zoo animals

**JOHOR BARU:** Hungry zoo animals became beneficiaries of agriculture produce that were about to be destroyed by the Malaysian Quarantine and Inspection Services Department (Maqis).

A department under the Agriculture Ministry, Maqis is the authority responsible for regulating the import and export of agricultural goods, and such goods can be seized if importers infringe Section 11,13,14, and/or 15 of the Quarantine and Inspection Services Act 2011.

According to Johor Maqis director, Nur Afifah A. Rahman, the agency's standard operating procedure allows such seized products to be used as animal feed.

"Items seized by Maqis will usually be buried or burned. In this case, turning them into food for animals reduces wastage as the produce can be used to ensure these animals do not go hungry," she said.

Recently, Maqis donated nearly five tonnes of seized produce, consisting of 4,290kg of cabbages, 90kg of beef, 160kg of both dried and frozen fish, 69kg of coffee beans, 6kg of dairy products and 2kg of frozen insects – to the Melaka Zoo as well as the A'Famosa Safari Wonderland.

Afifah said Maqis initially wanted to give the seized items to the Johor Zoo, but the zoo declined as they had sufficient funds to feed their animals.

The Johor Zoo then suggested giving the produce to zoos in Melaka instead.

Together with assistance from the Wildlife and National Parks Department (Perhilitan), the agricultural produce worth more than RM9,000 was transported to Melaka.

It was then unloaded at the park, which thanked Maqis for the contribution.

"It is a much appreciated gesture. All our parks are closed but Maqis has ensured that our animals remain fed," it said.

In another statement, the Malaysian Association of Zoological Parks and Aquaria (Mazpa) is also appealing for all forms of assistance, including financial help.

Representing 22 public and private zoos in the country, the association said they were facing uncertain times following the enforcement of the movement control order (MCO) since March 18.

Established in 1996, Mazpa supports in-situ wildlife management alongside promoting tourism in the country.
