PETALING JAYA: A Cabinet committee on National Food Security Policy has been set up to coordinate strategies and action plans in addressing national food security issues for the short, medium and long term.

The drafting of a more holistic and sustainable National Food Security Policy will strengthen food security at all levels of the food supply chain, said Agriculture and Food Industries Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiang.

The Prime Minister will chair the committee, and its members will include the Agriculture and Food Industries Minister, the Finance Minister, the Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Economic Affairs), the Science, Technology and Innovation

Minister and the Health Minister.

Others are International Trade and Industry Minister; the Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Minister, the Plantation Industries and Commodities Minister, the Transport Minister, the Rural Development Minister as well as the Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Special Functions).

The committee will seek input from stakeholders including academics, industry players, non-governmental organisations as well as farmers, animal breeders and fishermen.

Kiang stressed that in general, Malaysia's supply of food is sufficient. However, he also acknowledged the need to improve upon that position of security.

Orang awam dilarang mencandat sotong

Kuala Terengganu: Orang awam tidak dibenarkan ke laut termasuk melakukan aktiviti mencandat sotong sepanjang tempoh Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) dilaksanakan.

Pengarah Agensi Penguatkuasaan Maritim Malaysia (APMM) Terengganu, Kepten Maritim Muhammad Suffi Mohd Ramli berkata, hanya nelayan tempatan memiliki permit atau lesen sah Jabatan Perikanan Malaysia saja dibenarkan untuk tujuan berkenaan sepanjang tempoh PKP.

Beliau berkata, aktiviti mencandat sotong bermula April di Terengganu memang dinantikan peminatnya, namun aktiviti itu ti-

dak dibenarkan ketika PKP.

“Jadi, kami mengingatkan semua nelayan supaya tidak membenarkan individu atau kumpulan bukan kru sah berada di atas bot mereka bagi tujuan melakukan aktiviti mencandat sotong.

“Tindakan mengikut Peraturan 3 (1) Peraturan-Peraturan Pencegahan dan Pengawalan Penyakit Berjangkit (Langkah-langkah di dalam kawasan tempatan jangkitan) 2020 yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara sehingga enam bulan atau denda RM1,000 atau kedua-duanya sekali boleh dikenakan kepada mana-mana pihak yang ingkar,” katanya.

Jualan FAMA Kedah ketika PKP cecah RM11.88 juta

BALING - Lembaga Pemasaran Pertanian Persekutuan (FAMA) Kedah berjaya mencapai nilai jualan mencecah RM11.88 juta membabitkan Pasar Segar Terkawal di negeri itu sepanjang Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP).

Pengarah FAMA Kedah, Isa Hamzah berkata, jumlah itu adalah hasil jualan kepada 189,826 orang pengguna antara 18 Mac hingga 19 April 2020.

Menurutnya, dari segi pe-

masaran, FAMA telah membuat belian melebihi 80 peratus hasil keluaran petani dan berjaya membuat 333 pengaturan pasaran.

“Tiada isu lambakan berlaku di Kedah walaupun dalam tempoh PKP kerana FAMA telah berjaya memasarkan lebih 80 peratus hasil petani,” katanya ketika hadir ke sesi penyerahan sumbangan Kombo Ramadan. Petugas barisan hadapan di Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Baling di sini semalam.

Penyerahan disempurnakan Ahli Parlimen Baling, Datuk Seri Abdul Azeez Abdul Rahim.

Isa berkata, setakat ini Kedah mempunyai enam Pasar Segar Terkawal yang diluluskan beroperasi semasa tempoh PKP dengan prosedur operasi standard ditetapkan antaranya di Guar Chempedak, Changlun, Kuala Kedah, Kulim, Pusat Operasi FAMA Alor Setar dan Pusat Operasi FAMA Sungai Petani.
