Bolstering food security with new technologies from MAFI-MOSTI cooperation



Collaboration between MAFI and MOSTI could yield new technologies needed to strengthen the country's food security apart from ensuring sufficient food supply, MAFI Minister, Datuk Seri Ronald Kiandee said. - Astro AWANI

KUALA KANGSAR: Collaboration between the Agriculture and Food Industries Ministry (MAFI) and the Science, Technology and Innovation Ministry (MOSTI) could yield new technologies needed to strengthen the country's food security apart from ensuring sufficient food supply.

MAFI Minister, Datuk Seri Ronald Kiandee said the application of technology in the production of food such as the internet of things (IoT) and artificial intelligence (AI) are important for the viability of food supply for the benefit of Malaysians in future.

"Even if a plot of land is small, the production of food is still possible by using the best technologies to grow vegetables and fruits.

"We are confident of moving towards modern agriculture via the synergy of both ministries apart from the involvement of state governments and the private sector which could indirectly reduce dependence on food import.

"We have to reduce our food import including rice, fruits and vegetables and should instead maximise available capacity to export our produce to other countries," he said after visiting the Kuala Kangsar Permanent Agro Market (PTK) and the Agrofood Marketing Centre of the Federal Agricultural Authority (FAMA) in Manong.

Also present were Perak Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Saarani Mohamad, Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Special Functions) cum Kuala Kangsar MP, Datuk Mastura Mohd Yazid, state Plantation, Agriculture and Food Industry Committee chairman Razman Zakaria and FAMA director-general Datuk Zainal Abidin Yang Razalli.

Ronald added that efforts by the ministry and the agencies involved to ensure sufficient food in the country would not be affected by modern agriculture such as hydroponics.

In this regard, Saarani said the state government is prepared to increase the number of agrofood centres in the state apart from the one in Manong, Kuala Kangsar to improve the income of local residents.

"Agriculture needs new methods and technologies which do not require a large area. What is important is that the produce could be marketed by villagers. This is an important network to create food supply hubs and ensure sufficient food for security.

"We want to make Perak as the largest food producer. I am confident it could be carried out after discussions with MAFI and MOSTI. It can be a success as the Perak State Agricultural Development Corporation (SADC) has carried out farming projects for young agro farmers," he said.

Meanwhile, Mastura said the centre had fulfilled the dreams of the people of Kuala Kangsar as a hub for various agricultural products that had an impact on the surrounding community, especially youth who want to be involved in agriculture.

Through a press release, the FAMA Agro-Food Marketing Centre in Manong, Kuala Kangsar said the only such centre in Perak, has been upgraded on four acres of land as a business model and reference centre for the marketing of technological agricultural products.

The development of this centre can directly provide opportunities and exposure to the youth on the latest technology in the agricultural sector as well as optimise the use of idle lands owned by the government by applying the concept of IoT that is using fertigation, hydroponics and aquaponics in one area.

This project is also a manifestation of the government to optimise the use of idle and undeveloped land owned by the federal government and Malay Reserve land leased for agricultural or business projects.

Also present were Perak Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Saarani Mohamad, Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Special Functions) and Kuala Kangsar MP Datuk Mastura Mohd Yazid, state Plantation, Agriculture and Food Industry Committee chairman Razman Zakaria and FAMA director-general Datuk Zainal Abidin Yang Razalli.

Saarani said the state government was prepared to increase the number of agrofood centres in the state to improve the income of local residents. It has one in Manong, Kuala Kangsar.

"Agriculture needs new methods and technologies which do not require a large area. What is important is that the produce could be marketed by villagers. This is an important network to create food supply hubs and ensure sufficient food for security.

"We want to make Perak the largest food producer. I am confident it could be done as the Perak State Agricultural Development Corporation has carried out farming projects for young agro farmers," he said.

Mastura said the Manong centre was a hub for various agricultural products that had an impact on the community, especially youth keen to be involved in agriculture.

The Manong centre has various facilities under one roof, namely a training centre, sales and wholesale centre, agricultural site, cafeteria and hawker centre, Fresh Fruit Stalls and smart agriculture (aquaponics and vertical farming), fertigation agriculture project. — BERNAMA

Projek Pasar Tani Kekal Kuala Kangsar Perak bakal beri manfaat 100 usahawan



KUALA KANGSAR: Menteri Pertanian dan Industri Makanan Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee bersama Menteri Besar Perak Datuk Seri Saarani Mohamad telah melawat tapak Projek Pasar Tani Kekal (PTK) Kuala Kangsar yang bakal memberikan manfaat kepada lebih 100 orang usahawan apabila siap sepenuhnya pada April 2023.

Transformasi pasar awam sebagai Pusat Sehenti (One Stop Centre) dengan pengurusan yang lebih sistematik ini akan menyediakan 116 lot baharu terdiri daripada lapan lot runcit, lapan lot medan selera dan 100 lot terbuka yang dijangka akan meningkatkan pendapatan dan nilai jualan peserta sebanyak 30 peratus.

Pembangunan PTK Kuala Kangsar adalah secara kerjasama strategik Kerajaan Persekutuan yang memperuntukkan RM3 juta manakala Kerajaan Negeri turut memperuntukkan RM1 juta.

Untuk rekod, bilangan PTK di seluruh negara setakat ini adalah 40 dengan jumlah peruntukan keseluruhan sebanyak RM147.57 juta.

Selain PTK Kuala Kangsar, terdapat empat lagi lokasi PTK yang masih di dalam pembinaan iaitu di Kg. Gajah, Perak, FELDA Palong, Negeri Sembilan, Kuala Krai, Kelantan dan Seberang Jaya, Pulau Pinang.

Dalam lawatan yang sama, Ronald dan Saarani turut melawat Pusat Pemasaran Agromakanan FAMA di Manong, Kuala Kangsar yang telah dinaiktaraf atas tanah berkeluasan empat ekar sebagai model perniagaan dan pusat rujukan pemasaran hasil pertanian berteknologi.

Melalui pembangunan pusat ini secara langsung dapat memberi peluang dan pendedahan kepada golongan belia mengenai teknologi terkini yang tersedia di dalam sektor pertanian sekaligus mengoptimalkan penggunaan tanah-tanah terbiar milik Kerajaan.

Pusat Rujukan Pemasaran Hasil Pertanian Berteknologi yang juga sebahagian daripada Pusat Pemasaran Agromakanan FAMA dimajukan di tanah rizab Jabatan Kerja Raya (JKR) yang berkeluasan 2.5 ekar dengan mengaplikasikan konsep Internet of Things (IoT) iaitu menggunakan kaedah sistem fertigasi, hidroponik dan akuaponik dalam satu kawasan.

Untuk rekod, kaedah ini memberikan pulangan sehingga RM90 ribu pada satu tempoh dengan pengeluaran dua komoditi iaitu sayuran berdaun organik sebanyak 3.3 tan metrik tan dan ikan tilapia sebanyak 4,000 ekor.

Projek ini adalah manifestasi Kerajaan untuk mengoptimumkan penggunaan tanah rebiar dan tidak dibangunkan milik Kerajaan Persekutuan dan tanah Rizab Melayu disewakan bagi projek pertanian atau perniagaan.

Pusat Pemasaran Agromakanan FAMA Manong ini juga mempunyai pelbagai fasiliti di bawah satu bumbung iaitu pusat latihan, pusat jualan dan pemborongan, tapak pertanian, kafeteria dan medan penjaja, Medan Gerai Buah-Buahan Segar (GBBS) dan pertanian pintar projek pertanian fertigasi.

Seramai 23 usahawan yang sebelum ini berniaga di tepi jalan dan rumah persendirian juga telah dikumpulkan di sini dan dapat manfaat peningkatan pendapatan sebanyak 20 peratus.

Kerjasama strategik merentas Kementerian, Kerajaan Negeri dan pihak swasta seperti ini terbukti dapat mencapai matlamat pembangunan pemasaran agromakanan bagi memodenkan sektor agromakanan negara sejajar dengan Dasar Agromakanan Negara 2.0 (2021-2030) dan Pelan Tindakan Dasar Sekuriti Makanan (2021-2025).

Ini juga selaras dengan saranan Majlis Tindakan Ekonomi (EAC) yang diipengerusikan oleh Perdana Menteri supaya kerjasama antara Kerajaan Persekutuan dan Kerajaan Negeri diteruskan dalam usaha meningkatkan keluasan tanah bagi kegunaan pertanian untuk mengurangkan kebergantungan terhadap import makanan.

MAFI akan meneruskan kerjasama rapat antara semua pihak termasuk Kerajaan Negeri, Syarikat Pelaburan Kerajaan (GLC), Syarikat Pelaburan Berkaitan Kerajaan (GLIC) serta sektor swasta dalam usaha memperkukuhkan lagi agenda sekuriti makanan negara demi pertumbuhan sektor agromakanan dan kesejahteraan Keluarga Malaysia secara keseluruhannya.

RM200 juta subsidi telah dibayar kepada penternak ayam

KUALA KANGSAR: Kerajaan telah membayar sebanyak RM200 juta subsidi harga ayam kepada penternak dalam tempoh empat bulan sejak Februari lalu.

Menteri Pertanian dan Industri Makanan, Datuk Seri [Ronald Kiandee](#) berkata, jumlah itu adalah sebahagian daripada peruntukan subsidi sebanyak

RM729 juta bagi memastikan ayam standard dijual pada harga siling iaitu RM8.90 sekilogram.

Katanya, tuntutan bagi bayaran itu akan berakhir pada 30 Jun ini dengan lebih subsidi berkenaan tidak akan digunakan bagi tujuan sama.

“Kita akan alihkan lebih subsidi itu kepada bentuk lain seperti diumumkan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob (kepada golongan B40).

“Bila (sumbangan kewangan diberikan), akan ditentukan oleh Kementerian Kewangan,” katanya dalam sidang akhbar selepas mengadakan lawatan kerja ke tapak pasar tani kekal Kuala Kangsar dan projek pembangunan pemasaran agromakanan Fama Manong di sini hari ini.

Yang turut hadir, Menteri Besar Perak, Datuk Seri Saarani Mohamad; Ahli Parlimen Kuala Kangsar yang juga Timbalan Menteri di Jabatan Perdana Menteri (JPM) (Tugas-tugas Khas), Datuk Mastura Mohd. Yazid dan Ketua Pengarah FAMA, Datuk Zainal Abidin Yang Razalli.

Menurut beliau, pemberian subsidi kepada penternak adalah bagi meringankan beban kos pengeluaran yang semakin meningkat.

Bagaimanapun katanya, pemberhentian subsidi itu pada 1 Julai ini mungkin akan menyebabkan harga ayam meningkat kepada RM11 hingga RM12 sekilogram.

“Harga ayam kini dijual pada harga RM8.90 sekilogram iaitu di bawah harga pasaran di mana perbezaan sebanyak RM1.40 itu ditampung oleh kerajaan melalui pemberian subsidi.

“Jika harga ayam diapung, sudah tentu harganya melebihi harga siling yang ditetapkan sebelum ini. Jadi kerajaan telah memutuskan untuk mengalihkan pengagihan subsidi bukan lagi kepada industri tetapi kepada golongan B40,” katanya.

Tambah beliau, kerajaan juga maklum tentang kenaikan kos input ditanggung penternak merangkumi kos buruh, kos makanan ternakan dan kos pengurusan selain kematian ternakan disebabkan penyakit. —[UTUSAN](#)

Dalam perkembangan lain, Ronald memberitahu, kementeriannya akan mengemukakan beberapa pelan jangka panjang bagi mengatasi masalah pengairan padi di Kerian yang berlaku setiap kali musim kemarau.

Menurutnya, perbincangan masih berjalan di peringkat kementerian dan kerajaan negeri agar pendekatan terbaik dapat dicapai bagi mengelak kesan berpanjangan terhadap penjadualan tanaman padi di kawasan itu.

“Setiap kali tiba musim kemarau akan berlaku masalah terhadap takungan air di kolam tadahan yang menjejaskan pengairan.

“Bagi kawasan penanaman padi, pengairan adalah isu paling utama dan sudah tentulah, kita perlukan langkah jangka panjang untuk mengatasinya.

“Begitu pun, perkara ini masih di peringkat perbincangan untuk kerajaan perincian agar masalah sama tidak berlarutan,” katanya. – UTUSAN

The link between rural poverty eradication and agriculture has always been recognised under successive Malaysia Plans. For example, under the Third Malaysia Plan (1976-1980), agriculture remained “the dominant sector of the economy”, essential for “the attainment of the objectives of the New Economic Policy (NEP)”.

Nonetheless, a self-sufficient rural economy requires concerted and sustained state planning and intervention/pro-active measures – that go beyond the formulation of national strategic blueprints, such as the Malaysia Plans.

Think sectoral and sub-sectoral policies and programmes that are also organised along state-level lines – based on granular data. It also means that we need to strike the right/appropriate balance between our domestic needs and exports – between what may be called an “import-substitution” agriculturalisation and export-oriented agriculturalisation, at least over the medium-term period (five years).

This is to give our local agricultural sectors and related industries time to grow and develop, and which can be measured by our import dependency ratios and self-sufficiency levels. If need be, the state must be prepared and committed to:

1. Commandeer the agricultural and non-agricultural resources from the private sector to promote food security, but at the same time;
2. Ensure that the private sector can flourish and thrive in providing agricultural produce that allows us to have food security. The partial abolition of the approved permits (AP) – as a temporary solution – is a step in the right direction.

In other words, we need to have both forms of agricultural “protectionism” and “liberalisation” executed in tandem and synchronisation.

In protecting our agricultural sector, as part of the agenda to eradicate rural poverty, we need to tackle the issue of speculation and financialisation of food produce head-on.

This has to do with the transformation of forwards and futures contracts on which both the farmer/food producer and the markets depend for price stability (future) and discovery (spot) – paralleling the abuse of AP – as embodied by “derivatives”.

We should learn from the Great Food Crisis of 2008 (which badly affected Malaysia also) – which followed the onset of the Great Financial Crisis when the derivatives on mortgage-backed securities such as credit default swaps and collateralised debt obligations “exploded”. As primarily epitomised by the hedge funds, the speculators turned their attention to food crops/commodities.

When speculative activities in the international clearing (and hoarding activities in turn) are effectively addressed and essential/strategic food commodity items would not be

usually the case in the mainstream). This is not at all to diminish the role of supply-side and supply-chain bottlenecks but merely to point out the other reality.

Addressing this would go a long way to addressing food price inflation (purchasing power of consumers) and input costs inflation (purchasing power of farmers/producers).

Our poverty eradication agenda as embodied by the NEP – of which a drastic/radical update and “inversion” (up-side down reforms) are sorely needed – should not be hampered and held back by geo-financial vicissitudes when this is something that is even more within our control (internationally and domestically).

For example, the Bursa Malaysia Derivatives or BMD (as a result of a merger of the Kuala Lumpur Options and Financial Futures Exchange or Kloffie and the Commodity and Monetary Exchange of Malaysia or Commex) is a highly open futures market with a high degree of foreign interest.

Therefore, we may need to further regulate this area by imposing certain requirements for foreign speculators (i.e. through the Chicago Mercantile Exchange trading platform).

One of which is the condition that there must be physical purchases of stocks (the underlying assets), i.e. crude palm kernel oil, which can also be used to make chicken feed. That is, no cash settlement, physical settlement only (at the clearing process).

In turn, these underlying assets must be sold back to local buyers within a specified time-period (i.e. an additional contract that cannot be longer than three months). This practice could be replicated once BMD is further liberalised to allow for trading in rice and other food items.

This purely market-driven process has to run in parallel with the stockpiling-of-the-last resort (to ensure that prices in the rural sector and, by extension, the rural economy would be protected at all time/simultaneously.

wise (on paper), the rural hardcore poor are included within the same development plans. In reality, they are excluded and marginalised in terms of actual outreach – implementation and execution.

The competition between agricultural and industrialisation policies saw the former giving way to the latter – in terms of land use and space. And within the wider agricultural sector, commodities took priority over food crops. There is a need for a paradigm shift and solution to resolve the policy and existential tensions.

One in which we need to rebalance our national strategic portfolios to accord greater space to food agriculture as a matter of human and national security (like climate change, for example) on the back of 4IR (Fourth Industrial Revolution) technology or digitalisation such as Internet-of-Things, Big Data artificial intelligence and robotics – to allow for spatial overlap (i.e. multi- or inter-cropping).

When the NEP was first introduced in 1970, agriculture's share of the economy accounted about 30% or roughly one-third of the country's gross domestic product but has since declined to 10.5% in 2000. According to the Statistics Department of Malaysia, agriculture contributed only 7.4% in 2020.

Within the wider agricultural sector, the agro-food sub-sectors' contribution was at 48.2% in 2020, valued at RM52 billion.

Notwithstanding, of the estimated 5.3 million hectares of agricultural land in 2020, only 900,000 hectares (16.75%) are devoted to the agro-food sub-sectors. The rest, i.e. a whopping 4.2 million hectares (80.7%) is devoted to the "primary" commodities such as oil palm and rubber.

The current inflation phenomenon has heightened the exposure to our food insecurity and vulnerability to price shocks – heavily dependent as we are on food imports.

By inclusion, inflationary pressures have severely impacted our farmers as they are hit by a triple whammy of rising feed costs, prolonged labour shortages, and continuing price ceilings/controls – all of which eats into their already thin profit margins.

For example, a padi planter under the Muda Agricultural Development Authority (Mada) in Kedah – which contributes somewhere between 40% to 45% of the nation's total padi output – now has to pay RM78 for fertiliser, which used to cost RM50. Pesticides, hitherto, costs RM48 but is presently selling for RM90.

In 2016, the average or mean income of padi planters under Mada was only a meagre RM2,527 per month. It has to be highlighted that in addition to such disproportionate levels of income, most of the padi farmers are also in debt to both government and private entities.

It is reported that 300,000 padi planters are "drowning" in debt and, hence, the problem becomes inter-generational and, by extension, structural. The trend is also similar for other farmers – be it vegetables or poultry, etc. On top of that, there is the structural issue

In short, the global cost-push and supply-side inflation is hitting our agro-food farmers – the unsung heroes of the nat

The integrators (e.g. multinational companies/MNC in food manufacturing) provided basic inputs like day-old chicks and feed to the farmers. In turn, the farmers agree to sell back the fully grown broilers to the integrator at mutually agreed prices.

Contract farming would improve the efficiency of the supply chain and increase farmers' income and profit. It is, therefore, superior to government subsidies. This form of supply chain management (SCM) allows farmers to be connected to the global value chain via MNC and other private sector players.

A more integrated SCM will ensure competition among supply-chains, whether anchored by the public sector as via Fama, or the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority, or private sector via the cartels, monopolies and oligopolies (rather than old/conventional system of within the supply chain) – where digitalisation will ensure the winning edge.

It will also empower farmers with the critical exposure to market supply and demand dynamics in real-time since any information asymmetry is removed.

Empowering farmers with contract farming is key towards achieving a sustainable and self-sufficient rural economy.





First batch of round chicken stockpile to arrive June 18, says farmers' board

KUALA LUMPUR: The National Farmers' Organisation (Nafas) has started importing round chickens from poultry producers with the first stockpile of 21 metric tonnes in one container set to arrive Saturday (June 18).

The Farmers' Organisation Board (LPP), in a statement, said the supply was imported from poultry producers that had obtained approval from the Veterinary Services Department.

"The next chicken supply will be brought into the country on Monday (June 20), namely three containers that will be placed in the Nafas freezer room in Sungai Bakap, Penang," the statement read.

It added that LPP, through Nafas and State Farmers' Organisations (PPN), has been given the main task of implementing the chicken buffer stock programme to stabilise the country's chicken supply needs.

According to LPP, the programme would be implemented in stages, in collaboration with the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (Fama) and PPN, especially in terms of cold room facilities usage.

In addition, LPP said that the distribution of chicken would be done through PPN, Area Farmers' Organisations (PPK) and Fama networks, while LPP would monitor the implementation of import scheduling by Nafas.

Selangor PPN, Johor PPN and Perak PPN have been selected to assist Nafas in carrying out the programme and other PPNs would also be included based on current needs. - Bernama
