## Kuala Lumpur

Beberapa kedai runcit dan pasar raya di sekitar ibu kota didapati menetapkan syarat tertentu untuk pembelian beras putih tempatan (BPT) termasuk meminta pelanggan menunjukkan kad pengenalan sebagai bukti wangnegara.

Tinjauan mendapati peniaga mengambil langkah sedemikian bagi mengelak BPT dibeli warga asing, sekali gus memastikan wangnegara dapat menikmati komoditi itu pada harga subsidi.

Ada juga kedai didapati menghadkan pembelian BPT hanya satu kampil untuk setiap keluarga bagi membolehkan lebih ramai pelanggan dapat membelinya.

Peniaga, Sharon Pooi, 47, berkata, pihaknya baru saja menial BPT dan mengambil langkah ketat bagi memastikan hanya warga negara boleh membelinya.

"Kami memeriksa kad pengenalan setiap pembeli bagi mengelakkan beras ini jatuh ke tangan warga asing. Di kedai saya, setiap keluarga dibenarkan membeli dua kampil beras," katanya ketika ditemui.

Dia berkata, kedainya tidak meletakkan notis berkenaan had pembelian, tetapi mewajibkan pelanggan menunjukkan kad pengenalan sebelum membuat

pembayaran. Menurutnya, meskipun ada pelanggan yang mengadu mengenai syarat membeli kad pengenalan yang ditetapkan, langkah itu tetap diutamakan. "Kami memeriksa kad pengenalan setiap pembeli bagi mengelakkan beras ini jatuh ke tangan warga asing. Di kedai saya, setiap keluarga dibenarkan membeli dua kampil beras," katanya ketika ditemui.

las mengenai had pembelian dua kampil beras tempatan bagi setiap keluarga.

"Kami juga memaparkan notis bahawa pelanggan perlu menunjukkan kad pengenalan sebelum beras tempatan ini boleh dibeli," katanya.

Yaw berkata, langkah itu bukan saja bagi memastikan beras subsidi dijual kepada mereka yang layak, tetapi mengelakkan sebarang salah faham dalam kalangan pelanggan.

Juruwang sebuah kedai, Nurul Huda Ispan, 28, pula berkata, kedainya menetapkan setiap keluarga hanya boleh membeli satu kampil beras saja.

"Ini bagi memastikan lebih ramai pelanggan dapat menikmati tapi kami tidak meletakkan sebarang notis mengenai perkara ini di kedai," katanya.

Februari lalu media melaporkan Kementerian dan Kerajaan Makanan (KPKM) memberi jaminan BPT seberat 10 kilogram akan berada di pasaran seluruh Semenanjung.

Pembelian itu dihadkan kepada dua kampil setiap bulan bagi 400,000 ketua isi rumah (KIR) miskin dan dijual pada harga RM26.

# Bimbang 'tsunami' kedua jika penarikan subsidi dilaksana

**A**hli Dewan Undangan Negeri (ADUN) Kota Siputeh, Mohd Ashraf Mustaqim Badrul Munir antara pemimpin lantang memperjuangkan nasib pesawah sehingga ke peringkat nasional.

Justeru itu, wartawan *Sinar Harian*, **WAN MOHD NOOR HAFIZ WAN MANSOR** menemu bual Mohd Ashraf untuk berkongsi pelbagai agenda melibatkan isu pesawah dan juga pembangunan di Kota Siputeh.

Yang Berhormat (YB) dilihat prihatin dan mengambil berat isu kehidupan pesawah serta memperjuangkannya sehingga ke peringkat nasional. Selain Projek Pembangunan Infrastruktur bagi menyokong Program Penanaman Padi Lima Musim dalam tempoh dua tahun, apa lagi langkah awal perlu dilakukan untuk membantu pesawah?

Isu petani ini begitu dekat dengan saya selaku ADUN Kota Siputeh, ditambah punca utama pencarian hidup masyarakat dalam kawasan saya adalah melalui sawah padi di samping sebahagian kecilnya nelayan dan penoreh getah. Bagi langkah awal membantu pesawah, sekali lagi saya tekankan kerajaan perlu mengimbangi semula ke-meseletan kesan kenaikan harga diesel dengan memastikan langkah semasa yang seharusnya dilaksanakan dengan menetapkan harga belian padi RM1,800 per tan, bukan RM1,500 per tan selain mengawal kenaikan lain-lain harga kos input bagi proses penghasilan padi.

Adalah dijangka penarikan subsidi petrol dan kenaikan tarif elektrik akan mengurus 'tsunami' kedua menambah bebanan pesawah sedangkan isu kenaikan diesel masih belum berjaya mengimbangi hasil pulangan berpatutan kepada pesawah.

Pada pandangan YB, adakah inisiatif sedia ada mencukupi atau perlu ada penambahbaikan lagi, sekali gus usaha boleh dilakukan membantu pesawah meningkatkan pendapatan dan hasil pengeluaran padi mereka?



Kerajaan perlu meninjau semula peranan dan keperluan bagi mewujudkan Lembaga Padi Negara (LPN) demi kebaikan industri padi beras negara. Ini juga penting bagi menyelaraskan kembali pengusaha padi termasuk dari segi pulangan dan pengawalan dalam kos input.

Kerajaan juga perlu memperhalusi segenap permasalahan struktur dari aspek tata kelola kawal selia padi beras dan juga penyediaan serta penambahbaikan infrastruktur termasuk kelicinan aspek pengurusan dalam segenap proses penanaman padi sehingga penghasilan beras demi memastikan negara mencapai sasaran tahap sara diri (SSL) dicitrakan.

Penyusunan dan kejelasan atas peranan dan tanggungjawab agensi terkait, dalam segenap aspek rantalan pengurusan padi beras, sebagai contoh dalam pengurusan terusan dan tali air, kejelasan adalah perlu supaya tidak berlaku tolak menolak antara agensi kerajaan perihal tanggungjawab siapa untuk penyelenggaraan mahupun penambahbaikan infrastruktur.

**Pesawah sentiasa merungut kerana pendapatan diperoleh tidak tetap dan rendah, malah ada yang mengambil keputusan beralih ke tanaman lain terutama pesawah muda. Apakah penyelesaian boleh disuarakan YB untuk menyelesaikan masalah ini?**

Agenda anak tani perlu diketengahkan sebagai inisiatif menarik pesawah muda mengusahakan sawah bendang bagi mengelakkan warga asing mendominasi.

Selain itu, kami juga mohon kerajaan negeri berikan perhatian ke bahagian utara Kedah untuk pembangunan seperti apa sedang berlaku di selatan dan tengah. Utara jauh ketinggalan berbanding dua kawasan tersebut dari segi kemudahan.

**Bagi DUN Kota Siputeh pula apa lagi perlu dilakukan untuk merancarkan sektor ekonomi?**

Selain bawa isu padi untuk petani, saya ada mengetengahkan beberapa usul pembangunan termasuk juga memperkenalkan produk Kota Siputeh, Kodiang dan Sanglang untuk dimasyhurkan kepada khalayak sebagai kebanggaan Kedah.

Antaranya bangunkan industri produk batik dari kawasan ini iaitu lindungan bulan motif lokcan. Pokok lokcan hanya berada satu-satunya Kota Siputeh sahaja, tidak ada di daerah lain atau negeri lain.

Kita juga mahu angkat pelancongan sejarah Kota Siputeh kerana dulunya merupakan tapak pemerintahan Sultan Kedah selain kawasan rekreasi seperti Gua Kerbau dan Bukit Kodiang yang semakin dikenali.

Kita juga mahu ketengahkan produk tempatan melalui jenama *Make In Kodiang (Meko)* untuk menjana ekonomi baru masyarakat setempat dan sebuah yayasan akan membantu dari segi pendanaan dan sebagainya.

“To guarantee the stability of supply, (the ministry) always implements monitoring of the production and distribution of chicken eggs from the farm level to the end-user.”

Mohamad said enforcement measures are also being strengthened through strategic cooperation with other agencies and ministries to monitor the export of food supplies abroad.

He said the government, through his ministry, remained committed to ensuring the country’s food security through comprehensive policies and strategic action plans.

This includes efforts to increase local production capacity and provide support to the agro-food industry.

He advised the public not to engage in baseless speculation and to always refer to verified information through the ministry’s official channels.

## Smart SSB a novel way to up padi yield

KLANG: For padi farmers like Yap Kam Phua, a pioneering padi cultivation method introduced in Sekinchan in 2023 has brought them higher yields.

The harvest, he said, had doubled from the previous five to six tonnes per hectare since the

Sekinchan-style Large Scale Smart Padi Field (Smart SBB) initiative began.

“We used to suffer due to the low yield, but this method has changed all that.

“With the Smart SBB method, we also have time to do other things to supplement our income,” he said in an interview.

Yap said that many farmers were now reaping a higher yield by cultivating a hybrid variety of padi seeds from China.

“We can hit 14 tonnes per hectare by using the hybrid padi seeds.

“However, it is quite expensive. It costs about RM30 to RM40 per kg compared to the local variety which costs RM65 for a 25kg sack,” he said.

In January last year, then Agriculture and Food Security Ministry secretary-general Datuk Lokman Hakim Ali said that the Smart SBB would be extended to other padi cultivation areas in the country.

He noted then that 17 areas in Perlis, Kedah, Kelantan and Terengganu were already using the method.

Sekinchan assemblyman Datuk Ng Suee Lim, who is a prime mover in upgrading his constituency’s padi production, said the high yield smart method was the way forward for padi cultivation and rice processing industries.

Under the Smart SSB method, he said the old system of manually cultivating rice had been discarded and replaced by machines such as the usage of transplanters to sow padi seeds.

“With this method, there is a wider space between plants and this makes weedy rice (padi angin) easily visible and prevented from growing in tandem with the padi plant,” he said when contacted.

Weedy rice is a type of weed which resembles padi and “competes” with the real plant for nutrients and water.

Ng said that drones are used to sprinkle fertiliser and pesticide without much labour required on the field to care for the crops.



# 'Tambat dan kurung lembu anda'


- **Penternak perlu pastikan binatang ternakan tidak berkeliaran**

**GUA MUSANG** - Pengguna jalan raya terpaksa menanggung kerugian sebanyak RM150,000 membabitkan 25 kes kemalangan kenderaan melibatkan lembu berkeliaran direkodkan berlaku di daerah ini dalam tempoh dua bulan.

Ketua Polis Daerah Gua Musang, Superintendan Sik Choon Foo berkata, anggaran jumlah kerugian itu dicatatkan pada Januari dan Februari lalu. Katanya, sehubungan itu, penternak perlu lebih bertanggungjawab untuk memastikan binatang ternakan mereka tidak berkeliaran di atas jalan raya terutamanya pada waktu malam sehingga mengakibatkan kemalangan.

"Semua penternak terutama-

"Dalam tempoh Januari sehingga Februari lalu, sebanyak 25 kes kemalangan haiwan ternakan dilaporkan dengan jumlah kerugian RM150,000," katanya.

Choon Foo memberitahu, kawasan Rancangan Kemajuan Tanah (RKT) Kesedar Paloh dan Feida Chiku di sini, dilaporkan kerap berlaku kemalangan melibatkan haiwan ternakan.

Setiausaha Majlis Daerah Gua Musang (MDGM), Ahmad Hamdan Ubaidah berkata, sebanyak 20 tangkapan haiwan rayau membabitkan empat ekor kambing dan 16 lembu ditangkap sepanjang tahun lalu.

Katanya, operasi yang dilakukan secara bersepadu itu turut melibatkan anggota polis dan Jabatan Veterinar.

"MDGM memandang serius kejadian kemalangan yang membabitkan haiwan ternakan. Operasi bersepadu terhadap haiwan ternakan yang merayau di sekitar jalan terutamanya lautan utama di daerah ini dilakukan setiap bulan pada tahun ini," katanya.

## RM1.4mil Ramadan boom

KANGAR: The Ramadan Bazaar Tani, organised by the Perlis branch of Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (Fama), has recorded RM1.4mil in sales so far across its two main locations at Simpang Empat permanent farmers' market and Dataran ABC MAIPs, Kangar.

State Fama director Mohd Anzara Azizan said that the sales value involved 120 entrepreneurs and is expected to reach the RM1.5mil target, as the bazaar still has about 10 days remaining in its operation period.

"This bazaar not only helps boost the income of local traders, but also provides the public with access to a variety of agricultural products and fresh produce throughout Ramadan," he told reporters yesterday, reported Bernama.

Earlier, Fama distributed Sentuhan Kasih kits containing essential items to 30 asnaf (hardcore poor) who are congregation members of Masjid Al-Ariffin Padang Katong.

Kangar Municipal Council president Affendi Rajini Kanth and Mohd Anzara attended the event.

Meanwhile, Mohd Anzara said that to embrace the spirit of Ramadan and encourage acts of giving, the state Fama also organised the Sentuhan Kasih Ramadan @ Bazar Ramadan Tani.

He added that the programme, held three times since March 7, had successfully collected 600kg of food and beverages which were distributed to the community at eight mosques across the state.

# Essentials going for up to 70% discount

Event to be held across Johor ahead of Hari Raya

TO ENSURE a meaningful Hari Raya for lower-income groups, the Jualan Kasih Johor programme is being held across the state.

Johor agriculture, agro-based industry and rural development committee chairman Datuk Zahari Sarip said the initiative was part of the government's commitment to ease living costs.

"As with other major celebrations, the state government, in collaboration with Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (Fama), is organising Jualan Kasih Johor in conjunction with Hari Raya Aidilfitri."

The programme, until March 29, is being held at all 57 state constituencies.

Zahari, who is also Buloh Kasap assemblyman, added that the programme was launched at the Bandar Tenggara R&R in Kota Tinggi, Johor.

He said Jualan Kasih Johor offered discounts of between 50% and 70% on essential food items, thus helping locals purchase necessities at lower prices.

"Among the items available are chicken, fish and seafood, eggs and two-litre cooking oil packs.

"Fama will also provide discounts on other essential food items, including beef, vegetables, fruits and agro-based industry products," he said.

Zahari said the state government was targeting 200,000 visitors and the event would involve over

300 agropreneurs. "Johor government has allocated RM6.6mil for the programme under Budget 2025.

"Since its introduction in 2023, RM12.4mil has been spent on the initiative to support Johor citizens.

"All locals are invited to take advantage of the special discounts for the festive season."

## 93% of Kada padi fields expected to be harvested by June

KOTA BHARU: Over 25,000ha, or 93%, of the padi fields under the Kemubu Agricultural Development Authority (Kada) is expected to be harvested by June.

Speaking to reporters at the Perdana Iftar event with staff and media practitioners here on Saturday (March 22), Kada chairman Khalid Abdul Samad said that so far 4,574ah have been harvested with encouraging results due to fairly good weather during the Northeast Monsoon transition.

He said that for the past two consecutive seasons, farmers had suffered losses due to drought and floods, however, measures were taken to face the dry season this year.

"Fortunately, the anticipated drought in February and March did not occur, allowing farmers to reap their harvests as planned," he said.

Khalid also announced that reinforcement work on the sheet pile at the Kemubu pump station will begin before June, with an allocation of approximately RM5mil to ensure smooth planting for the next season.

He emphasised that this is an urgent measure to prevent a collapse that could disrupt irrigation.

He added that the state government has also approved Kada's request to construct a new sheet pile, and the agency is currently finalising its design. - Bernama
